

Curse of the days of Elijah

Thus saith the Lord, as it was in the days of Elijah, so shall it be at the coming of the Son of Man.

Remembering the things of the past occurred to warn of what's to come.

Romans 15:4 For whatsoever things were written aforetime were written for our learning, that we through patience and comfort of the scriptures might have hope.

Image of Baal brought curse of no rain 3.5 years or 1260 days which brought famines and the curse of them eating their children.

James 5:17 Elias was a man subject to like passions as we are, and he prayed earnestly that it might not rain: and it rained not on the earth by the space of three years and six months.

The Image of Baal was erected.

Romans 11:2 God hath not cast away his people which he foreknew. Wot ye not what the scripture saith of Elias? how he maketh intercession to God against Israel saying,

3 Lord, they have killed thy prophets, and digged down thine altars; and I am left alone, and they seek my life.

4 But what saith the answer of God unto him? I have reserved to myself seven thousand men, who have not bowed the knee to **the image of Baal**.

The same occurs in the end. For 1260 days.

Image of the Beast brings curse of no rain 3.5 years which brings famines and the curse of them eating their children.

Rev 13:15 And he had power to give life unto the image of the beast, that **the image of the beast** should both speak, and cause that as many as would not worship the image of the beast should be killed.

We see the 1260 days of prophesying occurs during this time of the image of the beast.

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto my two witnesses, and they shall prophesy **a thousand two hundred and threescore days**, clothed in sackcloth.

The rains are withheld during this prophesying of 1260 days and image of the beast.

Rev 11:6 These have power to shut heaven, **that it rain not in the days of their prophecy**: and have power over waters to turn them to blood, and to smite the earth with all plagues, as often as they will.

What occurred during time of Elijah was rains brought famines which lead to such famine people began to eat their children after rains had been withheld.

2 Kings 6:28 And the king said unto her, What aileth thee? And she answered, This woman said unto me, Give thy son, that **we may eat him to day, and we will eat my son to morrow.**

29 **So we boiled my son, and did eat him:** and I said unto her on the next day, Give thy son, that we may eat him: and she hath hid her son.

The parable Christ warns of in the end times is the same.

Luke 23:28 But Jesus turning unto them said, Daughters of Jerusalem, weep not for me, **but weep for yourselves, and for your children.**

29 For, behold, **the days are coming,** in the which they shall say, **Blessed are the barren, and the wombs that never bare, and the paps which never gave suck.**

30 Then shall they begin to say to the mountains, Fall on us; and to the hills, Cover us.

31 For **if they do these things in a green tree, what shall be done in the dry?**

If they are doing evil during the time of rain they will become more evil during time of drought.

This is fulfilled in the saying woe to those who suck in those days for there will be great wrath on these people....

Jesus says days coming. When those who can't or don't have children will be called blessed because they won't have to eat their children to survive.

These two chapter verses reference the same event. First with the Abomination of Desolation which is the image of the beast and the people are told to flee when they see it.

Matt 24:15 When ye therefore shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, stand in the holy place, (whoso readeth, let him understand:)

16 Then let them which be in Judaea flee into the mountains:

This is why Jesus is talking about the abomination of desolation (image of the beast) and follows immediately in verses after with woe to those with children because great wrath on them.

The image of the beast brings curse on earth and famines and people eat their kids and wrath.

Luke 21:21 Then let them which are in Judaea flee to the mountains; and let them which are in the midst of it depart out; and let not them that are in the countries enter thereinto.

22 For these be the days of vengeance, that all things which are written may be fulfilled.

23 But **woe unto them that are with child, and to them that give suck, in those days! for there shall be great distress in the land, and wrath upon this people.**

Image of beast is erected whole world honors it bringing the wrath of God and rains stopped.

Rev 13: 14 And deceiveth them that dwell on the earth by the means of those miracles which he had power to do in the sight of the beast; saying to them that dwell on the earth, that they should make an image to the beast, which had the wound by a sword, and did live.

15 And he had power to give life unto the image of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak, and cause that as many as would not worship the image of the beast should be killed.

The curse on world from image of beast set up is found in the curses for breaking the law of Moses.

Leviticus 26 Ye shall make you no idols nor graven image, neither rear you up a standing image, neither shall ye set up any image of stone in your land, to bow down unto it: for I am the Lord your God.

Lev 26:29 And ye shall eat the flesh of your sons, and the flesh of your daughters shall ye eat.

30 And I will destroy your high places, and cut down your images, and cast your carcasses upon the carcasses of your idols, and my soul shall abhor you.

Deut 28 curses for worshiping the image are also unleashed in the plagues and wrath.

Deut 28:53

53 And **thou shalt eat the fruit of thine own body, the flesh of thy sons and of thy daughters,** which the Lord thy God hath given thee, in the siege, and in the straitness, wherewith thine enemies shall distress thee:

The end times Elijah to come is here and will smite world with curses.....

Malachi 4:4 Remember ye the law of Moses my servant, which I commanded unto him in Horeb for all Israel, with the statutes and judgments.

5 Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the Lord:

6 And he shall turn the heart of the fathers to the children, and the heart of the children to their fathers, lest I come and smite the earth with a curse.

This is the prophesy of the rains withheld for 1260 days.
