

Silence in heaven on The DAY of the LORD.

Joshua sacking Jericho is a foreshadow of the end and the Day of the LORD.

The silence in Jericho before the sacking of Jericho is foreshadow of the silence in Heaven.

Josh 6:10 And **Joshua had commanded the people, saying, Ye shall not shout, nor make any noise with your voice, neither shall any word proceed out of your mouth**, until the day I bid you shout; then shall ye shout.

Josh 6;20 So the people shouted when the priests blew with the trumpets: and it came to pass, when the people heard the sound of the trumpet, and **the people shouted with a great shout**, that the wall fell down flat, so that the people went up into the city, every man straight before him, and **they took the city**.

We see that the people are commanded to remain silent then there is a great shout.

This is reflective of the day of the LORD.

Rev 8:1 And when he had opened the seventh seal, **there was silence in heaven about the space of half an hour**.

The seventh seal it is the day of the LORD, there is silence before the Lord in the Temple in Heaven as He is roused to prepare to war against the islamic armies on earth and to sack jerusalem.

1 Thess 4:16 For the **Lord himself shall descend** from heaven **with a shout**, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first:

The silence is written about the day of the Lord.

Zephaniah 1:7 **Hold thy peace at the presence of the Lord God: for the day of the Lord is at hand**: for the Lord hath prepared a sacrifice, he hath bid his guests.

Hold thy peace means to be quiet.

Habakuk 2:20 But the Lord is in his holy temple: **let all the earth keep silence before him**.

When Christ arises in the temple of God in heaven to return to earth all earth will keep silence.

Zechariah 2:13 **Be silent**, O all flesh, before the Lord: for he is raised up out of his holy habitation.

The day of the Lord He will rise and fight just like the days of Moses.

Exodus 14:14 The Lord shall fight for you, and ye shall **hold your peace**.

The Muslims will see that Christ is the King of kings and go to fight him on the Day of the LORD.

Even the Muslims on the Day of the Lord who come to fight Christ believe they are told to keep silent.

Hadith 1511 – 17 The Book of the Prohibited actions – chaptr 254 – the prohibition of backbiting
The Prophet said, "He who believes in Allah and **the Last Day** must either speak good or **remain silent.**"

Muslims you will be commanded to keep silent for that half hour on the day of the LORD because its written before Islam even existed in the prophesy.
