

No walls

No walls remain on the Return of Christ.

At the Return of Christ we see the great earthquake of the Resurrection splits the city with a rift.

Zech 14:4 And his feet shall stand in that day upon the mount of Olives, which is before Jerusalem on the east, and **the mount of Olives shall cleave in the midst thereof** toward the east and toward the west, and there shall be a very great valley; and half of the mountain shall remove toward the north, and half of it toward the south.

This great earthquake causes the city to split and Walls to fall down.

Rev 16:18 And there were voices, and thunders, and lightnings; and there was a great earthquake, such as was not since men were upon the earth, so mighty an earthquake, and so great.

19 And **the great city was divided into three parts**, and the cities of the nations fell: and great Babylon came in remembrance before God, to give unto her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of his wrath.

We see the tenth part of the city falls.

Rev 11:13 And the same hour was there a great earthquake, and **the tenth part of the city fell**, and in the earthquake were slain of men seven thousand: and the remnant were affrighted, and gave glory to the God of heaven.

Here is the same event mentioned by Isaiah

Isaiah 30:25 And there shall be upon every high mountain, and upon every high hill, rivers and streams of waters in the day of the great slaughter, **when the towers fall**.

The entering into the Millennium is when this occurs.

Joshua's taking of Jericho is foreshadow of Christ returning taking Jerusalem.

Joshua walls fall in taking Jericho.

Joshua 6:4 And seven priests shall bear before the ark seven trumpets of rams' horns: and the seventh day ye shall compass the city seven times, and the priests shall blow with the trumpets.

5 And it shall come to pass, that when they make a long blast with the ram's horn, and when ye hear the sound of the trumpet, all the people shall shout with a great shout; and **the wall of the city shall fall down flat**, and the people shall ascend up every man straight before him.

We see that Jerusalem is unwallled at this point and the people are at rest with no bars or gates.

This devil comes after the 1000 years to surround Jerusalem with Gog and Magog when unwallled.

Rev 20:7 And **when the thousand years are expired**, Satan shall be loosed out of his prison,

8 And shall go out to deceive the nations which are in the four quarters of the earth, **Gog, and Magog**, to gather them together to battle: the number of whom is as the sand of the sea.

9 And they went up on the breadth of the earth, and **compassed the camp of the saints about, and the beloved city**: and fire came down from God out of heaven, and devoured them.

The Ezekiel 38 is post millenia and we see this by Revelation 20

Ezek 38:10 Thus saith the Lord God; It shall also come to pass, that at the same time shall things come into thy mind, and thou shalt think an evil thought:

11 And thou shalt say, I will go up to the **land of unwalled villages**; I will go to them that are at rest, that dwell safely, all of them dwelling **without walls**, and having neither bars nor gates,

The walls of the city of Jerusalem will fall on Christs return accompanied by great haillstones following the verse about the city dividing into parts at the walls falling.

Rev 16:19 And **the great city was divided into three parts**, and the cities of the nations fell: and great Babylon came in remembrance before God, to give unto her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of his wrath.

The walls fall and then great hailstones hit the city.

Rev 16:21 And there fell upon men a **great hail out of heaven**, every stone about the weight of a talent: and men blasphemed God because of the plague of the hail; for the plague thereof was exceeding great.

This is the same occurance as warned by Ezekiel to Jerusalem prior about those saying Jerusalem will not see wrath and the walls will be protecting the city from hailstones.

Ezek 13:10 Because, even because they have seduced my people, saying, Peace; and there was no peace; and **one built up a wall**, and, lo, others daubed it with untempered mortar:

11 Say unto them which daub it with untempered mortar, **that it shall fall**: there shall be an overflowing shower; and ye, **O great hailstones, shall fall**; and a stormy wind shall rend it.

12 Lo, when the wall is fallen, shall it not be said unto you, Where is the daubing wherewith ye have daubed it?

13 Therefore thus saith the Lord God; I will even rend it with a stormy wind in my fury; and there shall be an overflowing shower in mine anger, and **great hailstones in my fury to consume it**.

14 **So will I break down the wall that ye have daubed with untempered mortar**, and bring it down to the ground, so that the foundation thereof shall be discovered, and it shall fall, and ye shall be consumed in the midst thereof: and ye shall know that I am the Lord.

15 Thus **will I accomplish my wrath upon the wall**, and upon them that have daubed it with untempered mortar, and will say unto you, **The wall is no more, neither they that daubed it**;

There will be no more walls and those who daubed it with untempored motar will also be removed.
