

## Tabernacle clothes

### Tabernacle stages exodus 25

The tabernacle for God and man has four layers of covering until you get to the holy place with God.

These are prophetically aligned with the ages of mankind until Christ restores mankind back to Eden.

The tabernacle would be clothed on the outside first with Badger Skin on top of Rams skin died Red.

Exodus 26:14 And thou shalt make a covering for the tent of **rams' skins dyed red**, and a covering **above of badgers' skins**.

These rested on top of Goats Hair covering.

Exodus 26:7 And thou shalt make curtains of **goats' hair to be a covering** upon the tabernacle: eleven curtains shalt thou make. 8 The length of one curtain shall be thirty cubits, and the breadth of one curtain four cubits: and the eleven curtains shall be all of one measure

This Goats hair then became covering over on top of the Fine Linen housing the Holy place.

Exodus 26:1 Moreover thou shalt make the tabernacle with ten curtains of fine twined linen, and blue, and purple, and scarlet: with cherubims of cunning work shalt thou make them.



Closest to God is clothed with the fine linen.

Then Goats hair.

Then Rams skin died red

Then furthest away from Gods presence is badgers skin which is an unclean animal.

These are the four stages of mankind and the presence of God that testify to the gospel.

First mankind was separated from God furthest by Adam sin the Garden being unclean.

Genesi 3:23 Therefore the Lord God sent him forth from the garden of Eden, to till the ground from whence he was taken.

Adam was considered to be unclean from sin from this point. The badger is an unclean animal.

Lev 11:5 And **the rock badger**, because it chews the cud but does not part the hoof, **is unclean to you.**

Then mankind was brought back to God through Christ who is the Ram/Lamb with his blood shed.

He wore red garments, died on the cross and returns in His garments dyed red from their blood.

Matt 27:28 And they stripped him, and **put on him a scarlet robe.**

Lamb that was slain. Lamb skin dyed red.

Rev 5:6 And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, **stood a Lamb as it had been slain**, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth.

Rev 19:13 He is **clothed in a robe dipped in blood**, and the name by which he is called is The Word of God.

This is the figurative lambs skin covered in red blood.

We then see the people of God clothed in Goats Hair sackclothe through the end.

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto my two witnesses, and they shall prophesy a thousand two hundred and threescore days, **clothed in sackcloth.**

The sign confirming this a sackclothe of hair is shown in the creation confirmed in heavens.

Rev 6:12 And I beheld when he had opened the sixth seal, and, lo, there was a great earthquake; and the sun became **black as sackcloth of hair**, and the moon became as blood;

This is the covering of the tabernacle of goats hair sackclothe.

Then we see the final layer closest to God in the tabernacle of Fine Linen.

Rev 6:10 And they cried with a loud voice, saying, How long, O Lord, holy and true, dost thou not judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth? 11 and **white robes** were given unto every one of them; and it was said unto them, that they should rest yet for a little season, until their fellowservants also and their brethren, that should be killed as they were, should be fulfilled.

Rev 7:9 After this I beheld, and, lo, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, **clothed with white robes**, and palms in their hands;

Rev 19:14 And the armies which were in heaven followed him upon white horses, **clothed in fine linen, white and clean.**

This is the end where those who followed Christ are clothed in fine linen closest to Him.

This is the prophetic significance to mankind found in the covering of the Tabernacle in wilderness.

The tabernacle clothing shows the prophetic stages of mankind's redemption even before Christ.
