

Edom blood.

The story of the end times 3 kings and river of blood is a foreshadow of the end times.

The story of Elisha in 2 kings 3: the battle with the king of moab

The story begins about people of God in the wilderness of Edom with no water from fountains.

2 kings 3:8 And he said, Which way shall we go up? And he answered, The way through the **wilderness of Edom.**

King of Israel leads the armies.

2 kings 3:9 So **the king of Israel went**, and the king of Judah, and the king of Edom: and they fetched a compass of seven days' journey: and there **was no water** for the host, and for the cattle that followed them.

The 3 kings are gathered from wilderness of Edom to battle the king of moab.

2 Kings 3:10 And the king of Israel said, Alas! that the Lord hath called these **three kings** together, to deliver them into the hand of Moab!

They enquire of a prophet who then prophesies water to come.

2 kings 3:11 But Jehoshaphat said, Is there not here a prophet of the Lord, that we may enquire of the Lord by him? And one of the king of Israel's servants answered and said, Here is Elisha the son of Shaphat, which poured water on the hands of Elijah.

Water prophesied to come for those at Edom in the wilderness.

2 kings 3:17 For thus saith the Lord, Ye shall not see wind, neither shall ye see rain; yet that valley shall be filled **with water, that ye may drink**, both ye, and your cattle, and your beasts.

2 kings 3:20 And it came to pass in the morning, when the meat offering was offered, that, behold, there **came water by the way of Edom, and the country was filled with water.**

The king of moab sees the river of blood

2 kings 3:22 And they rose up early in the morning, and the sun shone upon the water, and the **Moabites saw the water on the other side as red as blood:**

23 And they said, **This is blood: the kings are surely slain**, and they have smitten one another: now therefore, Moab, to the spoil.

The king of moab and his armies flee but is captured and killed.

2 kings 3:24 And when they came to the camp of Israel, the Israelites rose up and smote the Moabites, **so that they fled before them:** but they went forward smiting the Moabites, even in their country.

This is the same as the end times.

The story begins about people of God in the wilderness of Edom with no water from fountains.

During the 1260 days there is no rain on earth and famines. People of God are exiled to Petra into the wilderness of Edom.

Rev 12:6 And the **woman fled into the wilderness**, where she hath a place prepared of God, that they should feed her there a thousand two hundred and threescore days.

They enquire of a prophet who then prophesies water to come for them for the 1260 days.

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto my two witnesses, and they shall **prophesy a thousand two hundred and threescore days**, clothed in sackcloth.

Water prophesied to come for those at Edom in the wilderness.

Rev 11:6 **These have power to shut heaven, that it rain not in the days of their prophecy:** and have power over waters to turn them to blood, and to smite the earth with all plagues, as often as they will.

King of Israel leads the armies.

Rev 19:14 And the armies which were in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean.

Rev 19:16 And he hath on his vesture and on his thigh a name written, **King Of Kings**, And Lord Of Lords.

The 3 kings are gathered to battle the final king, the beast.

Dan 7:24 And the ten horns out of this kingdom are ten kings that shall arise: and another shall rise after them; and he shall be diverse from the first, and **he shall subdue three kings**.

3 kings coming to the mountains of Israel to battle the beast.

Rev 16:12 And the sixth angel poured out his vial upon the great river Euphrates; and the water thereof was dried up, that the **way of the kings of the east** might be prepared.

Here are the armies coming to help.

Rev 9:14 Saying to the sixth angel which had the trumpet, Loose the four angels which are bound in the great river Euphrates.

15 And the four angels were loosed, which were prepared for an hour, and a day, and a month, and a year, for to slay the third part of men.

16 And the number of the army of the horsemen were two hundred thousand thousand: and I heard the number of them.

The final king the beast sees the river of blood in Edom.

Isaiah 63:1 **Who is this that cometh from Edom, with dyed garments from Bozrah?** this that is glorious in his apparel, travelling in the greatness of his strength? I that speak in righteousness, mighty to save.

2 Wherefore art thou red in thine apparel, and thy **garments** like him that **treadeth in the winefat?**

3 I have trodden **the winepress** alone; and of the people there was none with me: for I will tread them in mine anger, and trample them in my fury; and **their blood shall be sprinkled upon my garments, and I will stain all my raiment.**

This is the King of Israel leading the battle creating a river of blood in Edom.

Rev 19:13 And **he was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood:** and his name is called The Word of God.

This is the armies against King of Israel.

Rev 19:19 And **I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies,** gathered together to make war against him that sat on the horse, and against his army.

The final king beast and his armies flee seeing river of blood but is captured and killed.

Rev 6:15 And the kings of the earth, and the great men, and the rich men, and the chief captains, and the mighty men, and every bondman, and every free man, **hid themselves** in the dens and in the rocks of the mountains;

16 And said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and **hide us** from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb:

Here is them being captured and a river of blood is created.

Rev 19:20 And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. **These both were cast alive** into a lake of fire burning with brimstone.

21 And **the remnant were slain with the sword** of him that sat upon the horse, which sword proceeded out of his mouth: and all the fowls were filled with their flesh.

The prophesy of the end is revealed in the book of 2 kings 3.
