Luke 12:24 Consider the ravens: for they neither sow nor reap; which neither have storehouse nor barn; and God feedeth them: how much more are ye better than the fowls?

The Day of the Lord comes and the Ravens will feast and be fed.

Ezek 32:3 Thus saith the Lord God; I will therefore spread out my net over thee with a company of many people; and they shall bring thee up in my net.

4 Then will I leave thee upon the land, I will cast thee forth upon the open field, and will cause all **the fowls of the heaven to remain upon thee**, and I will fill the beasts of the whole earth with thee.

5 **And I will lay thy flesh upon the mountains, and fill the valleys with thy height.**

6 **I will also water with thy blood the land wherein thou swimst, even to the mountains; and the rivers shall be full of thee.**

7 And when I shall put thee out, I will cover the heaven, and make the stars thereof dark; I will cover the sun with a cloud, and the moon shall not give her light.

8 All the bright lights of heaven will I make dark over thee, and set darkness upon thy land, saith the Lord God.

The day of the Lord cometh where the armies will be gathered.

The bodies of those who do not join with us will be filling the rivers and their flesh will be laid about on the mountains and valleys will be full from their corpses.

The Ravens will feed on the remains of these bodies on the Day of the Lord.

The prophet calls the birds and then the angel in heaven confirms.

Ezekiel 39:17 And, thou son of man, thus saith the Lord God; Speak unto every feathered fowl, and to every beast of the field, Assemble yourselves, and come; gather yourselves on every side to my sacrifice that I do sacrifice for you, even a great sacrifice upon the mountains of Israel, that ye may eat flesh, and drink blood.

18 Ye shall eat the flesh of the mighty, and drink the blood of the princes of the earth, of rams, of lambs, and of goats, of bullocks, all of them fatlings of Bashan.

19 And ye shall eat fat till ye be full, and drink blood till ye be drunken, of my sacrifice which I have sacrificed for you.

20 Thus ye shall be filled at my table with horses and chariots, with mighty men, and with all men of war, saith the Lord God.

21 And I will set my glory among the heathen, and all the heathen shall see my judgment that I have executed, and my hand that I have laid upon them.

The table of the Lord is prepared for the Ravens to eat.

The prophet prophesies to the Ravens and the Angel calls them to come feast.

Rev 19:17 And I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the fowls that fly in the midst of heaven, Come and gather yourselves together unto the supper of the great God;

18 That ye may eat the flesh of kings, and the flesh of captains, and the flesh of mighty men, and the flesh of horses, and of them that sit on them, and the flesh of all men, both free and bond, both small and great.

The feast for the birds is prepared as promised.

The Winepress of the Lord is food for the Ravens for them to feed on their remains.

Rev 19:21 And the remnant were slain with the sword of him that sat upon the horse, which sword proceeded out of his mouth: and all the fowls were filled with their flesh.

Those who oppose will become food for the Ravens as its promised.
