

Esau's birthright prophesy.

Esau (Edom) birth right was given to Jacob (Israel).

When a birthright is given it also means the land inheritance is given away also.

Esau sold his birthright to Jacob.

Genesis 25:30 And Esau said to Jacob, Feed me, I pray thee, with that same red pottage; for I am faint: therefore was his name called **Edom**.

31 And **Jacob** said, Sell me this day thy birthright.

32 And Esau said, Behold, I am at the point to die: and what profit shall this birthright do to me?

33 And Jacob said, Swear to me this day; and he swore unto him: and he sold his birthright unto Jacob.

Jacob is given the name Israel through the blessing and promise.

Genesis 32:27 And he said unto him, What is thy name? And he said, **Jacob**.

28 And he said, Thy name shall be called no more Jacob, but **Israel**: for as a prince hast thou power with God and with men, and hast prevailed.

The land inheritance for the Restoration of Israel begins in Edom which was a birthright to Esau in Edom.

The location of the restoration of Israel gathering is at Petra for the 42 months before the Messiah descends over Petra at Edom.

The land allotment inheritance through Israel is given to the children of the promise.

She will be fed without selling her birthright during a time of hunger.

Rev 12:6 And the woman fled into the wilderness, **where she hath a place prepared of God**, that they should feed her there a thousand two hundred and threescore days.

The woman is the restoration of Israel of God, the Church.

United together with the lost tribes and gentiles as one fold to inherit the promises.

Rev 12:14 And to the woman were given two wings of a great eagle, that **she might fly into the wilderness, into her place**, where she is nourished for a time, and times, and half a time, from the face of the serpent.

This location of her place is at Edom in Petra in the wilderness which was Esau's birthright inheritance in Edom.

This is the Israel of God exodus for the 42 months before Christ descends over Edom.

Isaiah 63:1 Who is this that cometh from **Edom**, with dyed garments **from Bozrah**? this that is glorious in his apparel, travelling in the greatness of his strength? I that speak in righteousness, mighty to save.

2 Wherefore art thou red in thine apparel, and thy garments like him that treadeth in the winefat?

3 I have trodden the winepress alone; and of the people there was none with me: for I will tread them in mine anger, and trample them in my fury; and their blood shall be sprinkled upon my garments, and I will stain all my raiment.

4 For the day of vengeance is in mine heart, and the year of my redeemed is come.

5 And I looked, and there was none to help; and I wondered that there was none to uphold: therefore mine own arm brought salvation unto me; and my fury, it upheld me.

6 And I will tread down the people in mine anger, and make them drunk in my fury, and I will bring down their strength to the earth.

7 I will mention the lovingkindnesses of the Lord, and the praises of the Lord, according to all that the Lord hath bestowed on us, and the great goodness toward the house of Israel, which he hath bestowed on them according to his mercies, and according to the multitude of his lovingkindnesses.

8 For he said, Surely they are my people, children that will not lie: so he was their Saviour.

Messiah descending over Edom to tread winepress beginning at Bozrah.

Rev 19:11 And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war.

Rev 19:13 And he was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and his name is called The Word of God.

Rev 19:15 And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

The return of Christ is at Edom over the remnant gathering before waging war to take back the promise land.

Here is the Israel of God restored at Edom on the next Exodus partaking in the land Inheritance of Esau's birthright given to Jacob(israel).
