

Balaam plagues.

The disobediant and the plagues.

The plagues of end times comes on those who rebell like Pharoah did in egypt, the children of jezebell and those who hold the doctrine of balaam.

Jezebel taught it is ok to break the ten commandments.

Rev 2:20 Notwithstanding I have a few things against thee, because thou sufferest that woman Jezebel, which calleth herself a prophetess, to teach and to **seduce my servants to commit fornication, and to eat things sacrificed unto idols.**

21 And I gave her space to repent of her fornication; and she repented not.

22 Behold, I will cast her into a bed, and them that commit adultery with her **into great tribulation**, except they repent of their deeds.

23 And **I will kill her children with death**; and all the churches shall know that I am he which searcheth the reins and hearts: and I will give unto every one of you according to your works.

Jezebels children are those who follow her teachings they will be put into the great tribulation and suffer death as it states. We know the great tribulation is the 1260 days.

This is warning to the Church who are disobeying the law of moses and not keeping the commandments. They are children of Jezebel who will be put into great tribulation.

Balaam was manipulating the word of God and teaching to break the commandments and those who followed after balaam recieved the plagues.

Rev 2:14 But I have a few things against thee, because thou hast there them that hold the **doctrine of Balaam**, who taught Balac to cast a stumblingblock before the children of Israel, **to eat things sacrificed unto idols, and to commit fornication.**

Those who follow after this way of Balaam will see the same events as warned before.

This is what occured with the people of Baal peor as well.

Deut 4:2 Ye shall not add unto the word which I command you, neither shall ye diminish ought from it, that **ye may keep the commandments** of the Lord your God which I command you.

3 Your eyes have seen what the Lord did because of Baalpeor: for all the men that followed Baalpeor, the Lord thy God hath destroyed them from among you.

What happened to Baal peor?

Numbers 31:16 Behold, these caused the children of Israel, through **the counsel of Balaam, to commit trespass against the Lord in the matter of Peor**, and **there was a plague** among the congregation of the Lord.

Balaam was teaching the people of God to break the commandments of God.

Numbers 24:14 And now, behold, I go unto my people: come therefore, and I will advertise thee what this people shall do to **thy people in the latter days.**

15 And he took up his parable, and said, **Balaam the son of Beor** hath said, and the man whose eyes are open hath said:

16 He hath said, which **heard the words of God, and knew the knowledge of the most High**, which saw the vision of the Almighty, falling into a trance, but having his eyes open:

Balaam was using Gods word manipulating it, plagues came on those who followed Balaam.

The curses from the judgements and plagues fell on those who followed after Balaam.

Numbers 25:5 And Moses said unto the judges of Israel, **Slay ye every one his men that were joined unto Baalpeor.**

Numbers 25:8 And he went after the man of Israel into the tent, and thrust both of them through, the man of Israel, and the woman through her belly. **So the plague** was stayed from the children of Israel.

9 And those that **died in the plague were twenty and four thousand.**

What we see is those are breaking the commandments twisting Gods word in baal peor.

They had plagues fall on them and kill them.

This is also what occurs in the end the plagues come on the people who dont obey the corrections.

Rev 22:18 For I testify unto every man that heareth the words of the prophecy of this book, **If any man shall add unto these things, God shall add unto him the plagues that are written in this book:**

19 And if any man shall take away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part out of the book of life, and out of the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book.

You see how it says the warning of the plagues adding and also how names are removed?

People say they cant have their name removed after being written. T

his is why in the same chapter the warning emediatly following Balaam is given about the warning of Nicolitians.

This is the doctrine of Nicolatians they taught you can break the commandments and still be saved.

Rev 2:15 So hast thou also them that hold the doctrine of the Nicolaitanes, which thing I hate.

The deeds of the nicoliatanes are breaking commandment without restraint.

Rev 2:6 But this thou hast, that thou hatest the deeds of the Nicolaitanes, which I also hate.

Both the doctrine of Balaam and the Doctrine of Nicolaitians are warned of in Rev 22:18-19

The plagues will come on those resisting for the 1260 days. Just like the days of pharaoh.

Rev 12:17 And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, **which keep the commandments of God, and have the testimony of Jesus Christ.**

Here is he 1260 days and the Remnant of God keeping the commandments of God.

Out of the mouth of two witnesses a matter is established.

This will bring forth the justification for the plagues coming on all those who refuse correction.

Matt 18:But **if he will not hear thee, then take with thee one or two more, that in the mouth of two or three witnesses every word may be established.**

Those who refuse to heed the corrections of the two witnesses will be plagued and suffer death.

Rev 11:3 And **I will give power unto my two witnesses**, and they shall prophesy a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

Deut 17:6 At **the mouth of two witnesses**, or three witnesses, **shall he that is worthy of death be put to death**; but at the mouth of one witness he shall not be put to death.

Refusal to keep the 10 commandments and to gather to the call to come to Jerusalem and assemble will have consequence for refusing the call to come assemble together for the next Exodus.

Heb 10:25 **Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together**, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and **so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.**

26 For if we sin wilfully after that we have received the knowledge of the truth, there remaineth no more sacrifice for sins,

27 But a certain fearful looking for of judgment and fiery indignation, which shall devour the adversaries.

28 He that despised Moses' law died without mercy under two or three witnesses:

The call to come to the gathering will not be something that is optional and neither is you keeping the commandments of God.

The plagues will be prophesied on the world who refuse to comply.

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto my **two witnesses**, and **they shall prophesy** a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

6 These have power to shut heaven, that it rain not in the days of their prophecy: and have power over waters to turn them to blood, and **to smite the earth with all plagues, as often as they will.**

The end has come and all will be called to follow correction and to gather for the Exodus.
