

Esau endtimes

Esau forsaking promise for food, turning on his brother to kill him is foreshadow of end times.

The birthright contained the promise of the messiah to come through the blessing.

Genesis 25:30 And Esau said to Jacob, Feed me, I pray thee, with that same red pottage; for I am faint: therefore was his name called Edom.

31 And Jacob said, Sell me this day thy birthright.

32 And Esau said, Behold, I am at the point to die: and what profit shall this birthright do to me?

33 And Jacob said, Swear to me this day; and he sware unto him: and he sold his birthright unto Jacob.

34 Then Jacob gave Esau bread and pottage of lentiles; and he did eat and drink, and rose up, and went his way: thus Esau despised his birthright.

Esau forsook the promise for food.

Genesis 27:41 And Esau hated Jacob because of the blessing wherewith his father blessed him: and Esau said in his heart, The days of mourning for my father are at hand; then will I slay my brother Jacob.

Esau then went to kill his brother Jacob Jelous because he wanted the blessing of the promise.

The warning is given to the church about this.

Heb 12:16 Lest there be any fornicator, or profane person, as Esau, who for one morsel of meat sold his birthright.

17 For ye know how that afterward, when he would have inherited the blessing, he was rejected: for he found no place of repentance, though he sought it carefully with tears.

Esau was rejected by God and found no place of repentance after selling his soul for soup.

This is a foreshadow of what occurs in the end times for the Mark of the beast for food.

Those who take the Mark of the Beast are like Esau.

Those who reject the promise of Christ that he has a place prepared to feed them in wilderness, will be starved into submission to take the mark of the beast.

Rev 13:16 And he causeth all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and bond, to receive a mark in their right hand, or in their foreheads:

17 And that no man might buy or sell, save he that had the mark, or the name of the beast, or the number of his name.

Those who take the mark will have no place of repentance.

Rev 14: 9 And the third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, If any man worship the beast and his image, and receive his mark in his forehead, or in his hand,

10 The same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out without mixture into the cup of his indignation; and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb:

11 And the smoke of their torment ascendeth up for ever and ever: and they have no rest day nor night, who worship the beast and his image, and whosoever receiveth the mark of his name.

Those who take the mark of the beast will persecute those with the promise just like Esau.

The beast will be set in power for 42 months while the children of the promise are in wilderness.

Rev 13:5 And there was given unto him a mouth speaking great things and blasphemies; and power was given unto him to continue forty and two months.

Those with the mark will make war against the saints wanting to kill like Esau wanted to kill Jacob.

Rev 13:7 And it was given unto him to make war with the saints, and to overcome them: and power was given him over all kindreds, and tongues, and nations.

Those who come to the Exodus to wilderness at Petra will be fed for the forty two months of this period according to the promise of Christ.

The warning be reminded not to sell birthright for food.

Heb 12:16 Lest there be any fornicator, or profane person, as Esau, **who for one morsel of meat sold his birthright.**

They who do not sell their birthright for morsal of bread will be given bread at wilderness.

Rev 12:6 And the woman fled into the wilderness, where she hath a place prepared of God, that they should feed her there a thousand two hundred and threescore days.

Rev 12:14 And to the woman were given two wings of a great eagle, that she might fly into the wilderness, into her place, where she is nourished for a time, and times, and half a time, from the face of the serpent.

The mark of the beast will be aluring to get food and selling birthright just like Esau.

Those who recieve this word will be given the name Israel like Jacob and be given the promise.

The story of Esau is foreshadow of the end times mark of the beast temptation.
