Dan 5:8 Then came in all the king's wise men: but they could not read the writing, nor make known to the king the interpretation thereof

Dan 5:16 And I have heard of thee, that thou canst make interpretations, and dissolve doubts: now if thou canst read the writing, and make known to me the interpretation thereof, thou shalt be clothed with scarlet, and have a chain of gold about thy neck, and shalt be the third ruler in the kingdom. 17 **Then Daniel** answered and said before the king, Let thy gifts be to thyself, and give thy rewards to another; yet I will read the writing unto the king, and make known to him the interpretation.

The Candlestick.

Rev 11:4 These are the two olive trees, and the two **candlesticks** standing before the God of the earth.

The prophet.

Rev 11:10 And they that dwell upon the earth shall rejoice over them, and make merry, and shall send gifts one to another; because these two **prophets** tormented them that dwelt on the earth.

The writing on the wall interpreted.

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto my two witnesses, and they shall prophesy a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.
