

Hand of the prophet.

Justice delivered at the hand of the prophet.

What did the people witness in times past?

Prophet would be sent to warn and slay them if they didn't listen...

1 Kings 17:18 And she said unto Elijah, What have I to do with thee, O thou man of God? art thou come unto me to call my sin to remembrance, and to slay my son?

This is also seen in the prophets of Baal to call them to serve the true living God.

1 Kings 18:21 And Elijah came unto all the people, and said, How long halt ye between two opinions? **if the Lord be God, follow him: but if Baal, then follow him.** And the people answered him not a word.

But they did not heed and it was too late for them.

1 Kings 18:40 And Elijah said unto them, Take the prophets of Baal; let not one of them escape. And they took them: and **Elijah brought them down to the brook Kishon, and slew them there.**

They were then turned the river into a river of blood.

And again we see the Lord affirming he sends His prophets to warn and execution of judgement,

Ezek 33:1 Again the word of the Lord came unto me, saying,

Ezek 33:2 Son of man, speak to the children of thy people, and say unto them, When I bring the sword upon a land, if the people of the land take a man of their coasts, and set him for their watchman:

Ezek 33:3 If when he seeth the sword come upon the land, he blow the trumpet, and warn the people;

Ezek 33:4 Then whosoever **heareth the sound of the trumpet**, and taketh not warning; if the sword come, and take him away, his blood shall be upon his own head.

Ezek 33:8 When I say unto the wicked, O wicked man, thou shalt surely die; if thou dost not speak to warn the wicked from his way, that **wicked man shall die in his iniquity; but his blood will I require at thine hand.**

The warning to the people is coming with the sounding of the trumpet and the execution of judgement at the hand of the prophet.

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto my **two witnesses**, and **they shall prophesy** a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

Rev 11:6 These have power to shut heaven, that it rain not in the days of their prophecy: and have power over waters to turn them to blood, and **to smite the earth with all plagues, as often as they will.**

This is the prophesying of the trumpets and bowl judgements at the hand of prophets.

Rev 11:10 And they that dwell upon the earth shall rejoice over them, and make merry, and shall send gifts one to another; because **these two prophets tormented them that dwelt on the earth.**

This is why you see the plagues written in the trumpets mentioned.

Rev 11:6 These have power to shut heaven, that it rain not in the days of their prophecy: and **have power over waters to turn them to blood, and to smite the earth with all plagues**, as often as they will.

The power to turn water to blood by the Trumpet.

Rev 8:8 And the **second angel sounded**, and as it were a great mountain burning with fire was cast into the sea: and the **third part of the sea became blood;**

Just as the Lord said to ezeziel about warning and the sound of the trumpet....

Ezek 33:4 Then whosoever **heareth the sound of the trumpet**, and taketh not warning; if the sword come, and take him away, his blood shall be upon his own head.

This is why you see the last trumpet at the death of the prophets which is Christ returning.

Rev 11:11 And after three days and an half the spirit of life from God entered into them, and **they stood upon their feet;** and great fear fell upon them which saw them.

Rev 11:13 **And the same hour** was there a great earthquake, and the tenth part of the city fell, and in the earthquake were slain of men seven thousand: and the remnant were affrighted, and gave glory to the God of heaven.

14 The second woe is past; and, behold, the third woe cometh quickly.

15 And **the seventh angel sounded;** and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of his Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever.

This is the warning of the prophet, the sound of the trumpet, and the delegation of judgement at the hand of the prophet during 1260 days.
