

## Christ in Jordan

Christ was first revealed in the wilderness of Jordan and will be revealed the same at His return.

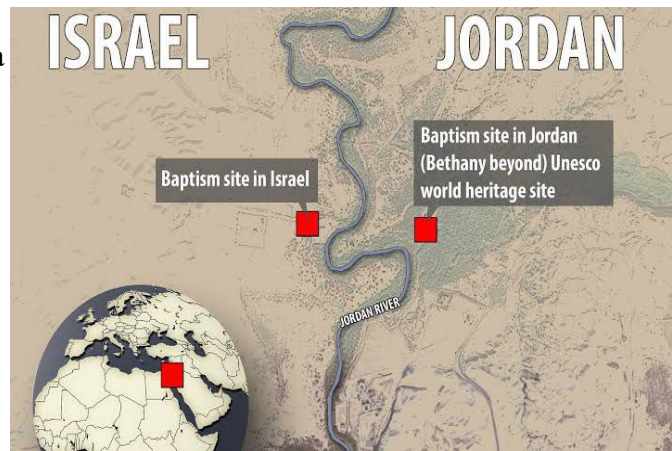
John was baptising at the wilderness beyond the Jordan river in Jordan called Al-Maghtas.

John 1:28 These things were done in Bethabara beyond Jordan, where John was baptizing.

John 10:40 And went away again beyond Jordan into the place where John at first baptized; and there he abode.

Jordan's wilderness was the location in which Christ was revealed to the world.



Matt 3:5 Then went out to him Jerusalem, and all Judaea, and **all the region round about Jordan**,  
6 And were baptized of him **in Jordan**, confessing their sins.

John saw Christ coming to Jordan and declared Him to be the Lamb of God and the Son of God.

John 1:28 These things were done in Bethabara beyond Jordan, where John was baptizing.  
29 The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, **Behold the Lamb of God**, which taketh away the sin of the world.

John 1:34 And I saw, and bare record that this **is the Son of God**.  
35 Again the next day after John stood, and two of his disciples;  
36 And looking upon **Jesus as he walked, he saith, Behold the Lamb of God!**

This is the manner which Christ will also return.

Christ will return in the wilderness of Jordan at Petra up the Jordan valley and through Jericho.

Isaiah 63:1 **Who is this that cometh from Edom**, with dyed garments from Bozrah? this that is glorious in his apparel, travelling in the greatness of his strength? I that speak in righteousness, mighty to save.

2 Wherefore art thou red in thine apparel, and thy garments like him that treadeth in the winefat?



3 I have trodden the winepress alone; and of the people there was none with me: **for I will tread them in mine anger, and trample them in my fury; and their blood shall be sprinkled upon my garments, and I will stain all my raiment.**

Christ is revealed from the wilderness of Jordan just like the days of John the baptist.
