

Dry Jordan river

Walking over the Jordan river on Dry land and the end times prophesy.

When Joshua brought the children of Israel through the Jordan pass into Jericho and up to Jerusalem coming into the land from the wilderness on the Exodus the children of Israel walked on dry land.

Joshua 3:8 And thou shalt command the priests that bear the ark of the covenant, saying, When ye are come to the brink of the water of Jordan, **ye shall stand still in Jordan.**

9 And Joshua said unto the children of Israel, Come hither, and hear the words of the Lord your God.

11 Behold, the ark of the covenant of the Lord of all the earth passeth over before you into Jordan.

12 Now therefore take you twelve men out of the tribes of Israel, out of every tribe a man.

13 And it shall come to pass, as soon as the soles of the feet of the priests that bear the ark of the Lord, the Lord of all the earth, shall rest in the waters of Jordan, **that the waters of Jordan shall be cut off from the waters** that come down from above; and they shall stand upon an heap.

Joshua 3:15 And as they that bare the ark were come unto Jordan, and the feet of the priests that bare the ark were dipped in the brim of the water, (for Jordan overfloweth all his banks all the time of harvest,)

16 That the waters which came down from above stood and rose up upon an heap very far from the city Adam, that is beside Zaretan: and those that came down toward the sea of the plain, even the salt sea, failed, and were cut off: and the people passed over right against Jericho.

17 And the priests that bare the ark of the covenant of the Lord stood firm on dry ground in the midst of Jordan, **and all the Israelites passed over on dry ground, until all the people were passed clean over Jordan.**

This crossing of the Jordan was set for crossing on Dry land for the Children of Israel entering into the land of Israel.

This is also foreshadow of the time of Elijah for what will be seen in the end times.

Elijah smote the waters and they walked over on Dry Land.

2 Kings 2:7 And fifty men of the sons of the prophets went, and stood to view afar off: and they two stood by Jordan.

8 And Elijah took his mantle, and wrapped it together, and **smote the waters**, and they were divided hither and thither, so that they two went over on dry ground.

9 And it came to pass, when they were gone over, that Elijah said unto Elisha, Ask what I shall do for thee, before I be taken away from thee. And Elisha said, I pray thee, let a double portion of thy spirit be upon me.

We smite the waters for the end times as its is written.

Rev 11:6 **These have power to shut heaven, that it rain not in the days of their prophecy:** and have power over waters to turn them to blood, and **to smite the earth** with all plagues, as often as they will.

This leads to 1260 days of no rain during the last 42 months of the great tribulation.

James 5:17 Elias was a man subject to like passions as we are, and he prayed earnestly that it might not rain: and **it rained not on the earth by the space of three years and six months.**

The river jordan will be dried up for the return of Christ where Christ returns over Petra and the armies of the Lord gather up the route to cross over the Jordan again on Dry land.
