

Christ retribution

The Rod, the Reed, a thief in the night and Retribution.

The people preaching Christ comes unexpected because the term thief in the night are false teachers.

Christ told His disciples he was going to be betrayed that night when He was taken.

When Christ was taken, he was taken like a thief in the night with sword.

Mathew 26:55 In that same hour said Jesus to the multitudes, **Are ye come out as against a thief with swords and staves for to take me?** I sat daily with you teaching in the temple, and ye laid no hold on me.

He knew the HOUR they would come and told them the hour if they watched and prayed.

Matt 26:40 And he cometh unto the disciples, and findeth them asleep, and saith unto Peter, What, could ye not **watch with me one hour?**

41 **Watch and pray**, that ye enter not into temptation: the spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak.

He knew the Hour.

Matt 26 45 Then cometh he to his disciples, and saith unto them, Sleep on now, and take your rest: behold, **the hour is at hand**, and the Son of man is betrayed into the hands of sinners.

The man fled naked when they came to him like a thief in the night.

Mark 14:50 And they all forsook him, and fled.

51 And there followed him a certain young man, having a linen cloth cast about his naked body; and the young men laid hold on him:

52 And he left the linen cloth, and **fled from them naked.**

This will become clearer as we unveil the real proper interpretation of what is to take place.

They then sent TWO FALSE WITNESSES to put Him to death.

Matthew 26:58 But Peter followed him afar off unto the high priest's palace, and went in, and sat with the servants, to see the end.

59 Now the chief priests, and elders, and all the council, sought false witness against Jesus, to put him to death;

60 But found none: yea, though many false witnesses came, yet found they none. **At the last came two false witnesses,**

Testifyign of the death and resurrection after 3 days.

Matthew 26:61 And said, This fellow said, I am able to destroy the temple of God, and to build it in **three days.**

**The mocking and scoffing Christ then began.**

They smacked Him telling Him to prophesy to them.

Matthew 26:67 Then did they spit in his face, and buffeted him; and others smote him with the palms of their hands,

68 Saying, **Prophesy unto us, thou Christ, Who is he that smote thee?**

They put a Red Robe on Christ.

Matth 27:28 And they stripped him, and **put on him a scarlet robe.**

They placed a Reed in His hand like a sceptre and smote him on the head with it.

Matthew 27:29 And when they had platted a crown of thorns, they put it upon his head, **and a reed in his right hand:** and they bowed the knee before him, and mocked him, saying, Hail, King of the Jews!

30 And they spit upon him, and **took the reed, and smote him on the head.**

On His death the Sun was darkened.

Matt 28:45 Now from the sixth hour there was **darkness over all the land unto the ninth hour.**

### **The Retribution**

Christ returns in the night during 3 days of darkness when there is no sun or moon light.

Rev 6:12 And I beheld when he had opened the sixth seal, and, lo, there was a great earthquake; and **the sun became black** as sackcloth of hair, and the moon became as blood;

Matt 24:29 Immediately after the tribulation of those days shall the **sun be darkened**, and the moon shall not give her light, and the stars shall fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens shall be shaken:

30 And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.

He takes them like they took him like a thief in the night and warns of the naked man who fled.

Rev 16:Behold, **I come as a thief. Blessed is he that watcheth**, and keepeth his garments, **lest he walk naked, and they see his shame.**

Knowing the hour if you watch and pray you will know the hour He comes like a thief in night.

Rev 3:3 Remember therefore how thou hast received and heard, and hold fast, and repent. If therefore **thou shalt not watch, I will come on thee as a thief, and thou shalt not know what hour I will come upon thee.**

Christ is wearing a Robe dipped in the blood from slaying those who oppose Him with the sword.

Rev 19:13 And he was clothed with **a vesture dipped in blood:** and his name is called The Word of God.

Christ will take the Rod of Iron like the reed they hit him with and he will smite the nations.

Rev 2:27 And **he shall rule them with a rod of iron**; as the vessels of a potter shall they be broken to shivers: even as I received of my Father.

Rev 19:15 And out of his mouth goeth a **sharp sword**, that with it he should smite the nations: and **he shall rule them with a rod of iron**: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

He comes at them in the night with the sword.

Rev 19:21 And the remnant were slain with **the sword of him that sat upon the horse, which sword proceeded out of his mouth**: and all the fowls were filled with their flesh.

But before they are put to death. Those in the world Christ sends two witnesses to testify why they are to be put to death for all those who oppose Christ.

Revelation 11:3 And I will give power unto my **two witnesses**, and **they shall prophesy** a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

They smacked him mocking Him telling Him to prophesy to them. He sends prophesying to them.

Testifying that they must be put to death.

Rev 11:5 And if any man will hurt them, fire proceedeth out of their mouth, and devoureth their enemies: and **if any man will hurt them, he must in this manner be killed**.

Testifying against the world who crucified Christ that they will be put to death.

Rev 11: 7 And when **they shall have finished their testimony**, the beast that ascendeth out of the bottomless pit shall make war against them, and shall overcome them, and kill them.

Testifying of the death and resurrection after 3 days.

Rev 11:8 And their dead bodies shall lie in the street of the great city, which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt, where also our Lord was crucified.

9 And they of the people and kindreds and tongues and nations shall see **their dead bodies three days and an half**, and shall not suffer their dead bodies to be put in graves.

10 And they that dwell upon the earth shall rejoice over them, and make merry, and shall send gifts one to another; because these two prophets tormented them that dwelt on the earth.

11 And **after three days and an half** the spirit of life from God entered into them, and **they stood upon their feet**; and great fear fell upon them which saw them.

When they kill us the Sun will go black for these 3 days just like when they killed Christ the sun was darkened.
