

Elijah and salt

The prophesy of the endtimes is found in the story of Elijah and salt.

2 Kings 2:19 And the men of the city said unto Elisha, Behold, I pray thee, the situation of this city is pleasant, as my lord seeth: but the water is naught, and the ground barren.

20 And he said, Bring me a **new cruse, and put salt therein**. And they brought it to him.

21 And he went forth unto **the spring of the waters, and cast the salt in there**, and said, Thus saith the Lord, I have healed these waters; there shall not be from thence any more death or barren land.

Elijah put the salt in the water and in the new cruse of water.

This is foreshadowing of the foot wash of the Woman in the end times.

The Church must have thier feet washed with salty water in the basin of water.

Christ has commanded all feet must be washed in the Church as consecration of the Church.

All priests had to have thier feet cerimonially consecrated by foot washing before they served as priests.

Exodus 40:30 And he set the laver between the tent of the congregation and the altar, and put water there, to wash withal.

31 And Moses and Aaron and his sons washed their hands and their feet thereat:

32 When they went into the tent of the congregation, and when they came near unto the altar, they washed; as the Lord commanded Moses.

Mary magdaline washed Christs feet with her tears and anointing His head as the High priest.

She anointed His head as the High Priest would be anointed.

Matt 26:7 There came unto him a woman having an alabaster box of very precious ointment, and **poured it on his head**, as he sat at meat.

Then she washed his feet with her tears which is salt water.

Luke 7:37 And, behold, a woman in the city, which was a sinner, when she knew that Jesus sat at meat in the Pharisee's house, brought an alabaster box of ointment,

38 **And stood at his feet behind him weeping, and began to wash his feet with tears**, and did wipe them with the hairs of her head, and kissed his feet, and anointed them with the ointment.

Mary consecrated Christs feet as the High priest with the salt water of her tears.

Then Christ before partaking of the table of bread and wine which was reserved for priests only.

Christ then washed the disciples feet preparing them to be priests.

John 13:3 Jesus knowing that the Father had given all things into his hands, and that he was come from God, and went to God;

4 He riseth from supper, and laid aside his garments; and took a towel, and girded himself.

5 After that **he poureth water into a bason, and began to wash the disciples' feet**, and to wipe them with the towel wherewith he was girded.

Peter refused to have his feet washed and Christ rebuked him.

John 13:6 Then cometh he to Simon Peter: and Peter saith unto him, Lord, **dost thou wash my feet?**

7 Jesus answered and said unto him, What I do thou knowest not now; but **thou shalt know hereafter.**

8 Peter saith unto him, Thou shalt never wash my feet. Jesus answered him, **If I wash thee not, thou hast no part with me.**

Jesus said if you do not have your feet washed you will have no part with Him.

He then explains that its commanded to do this to others in the Church.

John 13:13 Ye call me Master and Lord: and ye say well; for so I am.

14 If I then, your Lord and Master, have washed your feet; ye also ought to wash one another's feet.

15 For I have given you an example, that ye should do as I have done to you.

The High Priest given the ordinance to wash the feet in the ceremonial consecration as done to the apostles as was done to Christ.

The blessing is on those who obey and do the commandment.

John 13:17 If you know these things, **blessed are you if you do them.**

The time of the end has come for the Kingdom of God to have their feet washed before the wedding.

All the feet must be washed in accordance to Mary with the Salt water in the basin.

The entire earth will hear this message for the Kingdom of God.

Matt 26:13 Verily I say unto you, **Wheresoever this gospel shall be preached in the whole world, there shall also this, that this woman hath done, be told for a memorial of her.**

What Mary had done was wash the feet with her salt water (tears) and its commanded to you.

Matt 24:14 And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come.

The Kingdom of God is coming and all feet must be washed with salt water.

Under the banner of the Kingdom of God the alabaster stone the white onyx in memorial to Mary who washed the feet of the High Priest and anointed Him with her alabaster white onyx jar of oil.



Elijah is here commanding you to put salt in the cruse put salt in the basin of water and wash the feet.
