

Seek 3 days

Seeking the prophet for 3 days.

During the time of Elijah he had left then they began seeking him for 3 days.

2 Kings 2:17 And when they urged him till he was ashamed, he said, Send. They sent therefore fifty men; and they sought **three days**, but found him not.

This is forshadow of the end.

You will search for the prophet forshadowed in Elijah but will not be found for the 3 days.

Rev 11:9 And they of the people and kindreds and tongues and nations **shall see their dead bodies three days** and an half, and shall not suffer their dead bodies to be put in graves.

Just like Elijah was taken up.

2 Kings 2:11 And it came to pass, as they still went on, and talked, that, behold, there appeared a chariot of fire, and horses of fire, and parted them both asunder; and **Elijah went up by a whirlwind into heaven.**

We will be taken up by a whirlwind of the Spirit in the Resurrection to meet Christ as He is descending to earth with His horses of fire.

Rev 19:14 And **the armies which were in heaven followed him upon white horses**, clothed in fine linen, white and clean.

The whirlwind of the Spirit resurrecting to gather to Christ with the armies.

Rev 11:11 And after **three days** and an half the spirit of life from God entered into them, and they stood upon their feet; and great fear fell upon them which saw them.

12 And they heard a great voice from heaven saying unto them, Come up hither. And **they ascended up to heaven in a cloud**; and their enemies beheld them.

The story of Elijah and Elisha is the foreshadow of the end times prophets found in the book of 2 kings 2 seeking the prophet for 3 days and ascending to heaven with horses and armies.
