

Christ in midst

The voice in the midst of the living creatures and the famine declared by Christ is seen in prophesy.

Who has throne in midst of the four living creatures?

Rev 4:6 And before the throne there was a sea of glass like unto crystal: and **in the midst of the throne, and round about the throne, were four beasts full of eyes** before and behind.

The throne is in the midst of the four living creatures.

Rev 5:6 And I beheld, and, lo, **in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts**, and in the midst of the elders, **stood a Lamb** as it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth.

Christ is standing in the midst of the four living creatures.

This is the vision Isaiah saw where Christ was in the midst of the four living creatures speaking.

Isaiah 6:6 In the year that king Uzziah died **I saw also the Lord sitting upon a throne**, high and lifted up, and his train filled the temple.

2 **Above it stood the seraphims**: each one had six wings; with twain he covered his face, and with twain he covered his feet, and with twain he did fly.

3 And one cried unto another, and said, **Holy, holy, holy, is the Lord of hosts: the whole earth is full of his glory.**

4 And the posts of the door moved at the voice of him that cried, and the house was filled with smoke.

5 Then said I, Woe is me! for I am undone; because I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips: **for mine eyes have seen the King, the Lord of hosts.**

6 Then flew one of the seraphims unto me, having a live coal in his hand, which he had taken with the tongs from off the altar:

7 And he laid it upon my mouth, and said, Lo, this hath touched thy lips; and thine iniquity is taken away, and thy sin purged.

8 Also **I heard the voice of the Lord**, saying, Whom shall I send, and who will go for us? Then said I, Here am I; send me.

Here we see the voice of the Lord speaking from among the four living creatures called Seraphim.

The same four beasts Sing holy holy holy before the throne.

Rev 4:7 And the **first beast was like a lion**, and the **second beast like a calf**, and the **third beast had a face as a man**, and the **fourth beast was like a flying eagle**.

8 And **the four beasts had each of them six wings about him**; and **they were full of eyes** within: and they rest not day and night, saying, **Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty**, which was, and is, and is to come.

These four living creatures were full of eyes as seen in Revelation

Ezekiel also saw the four living creatures full of eyes and face of a lion , calf , an eagle and man.

Ezekiel 1:5 Also out of the midst thereof came the likeness of **four living creatures**. And this was their appearance; they had the likeness of a man.

Ezekiel 1:10 As for the likeness of their faces, they four had the **face of a man**, and the **face of a lion**, on the right side: and they four had the **face of an ox** on the left side; they four also had the **face of an eagle**.

11 Thus were their faces: and their wings were stretched upward; two wings of every one were joined one to another, and two covered their bodies.

Here is their eyes round about like the book of Revelation.

Ezek 1:18 As for their rings, they were so high that they were dreadful; and their rings **were full of eyes round about them four**.

In the midst of the four living creatures was a MAN on the throne.

Ezek 1:26 And above the firmament that was over their heads was the likeness of a throne, as the appearance of a sapphire stone: and **upon the likeness of the throne was the likeness as the appearance of a man above upon it**.

This man from the midst of the four living creatures spoke to Ezekiel ..

Ezekiel 2:1 And **he said unto me**, Son of man, stand upon thy feet, and I will speak unto thee.

This is Christ speaking to Ezekiel.

In the Psalms it talks about the Lord call for breaking the staff of bread.

Psalm 105:16 Moreover he called for a famine upon the land: **he brake the whole staff of bread**.

The prophet ezeziel was told that the voice speaking to him from the midst of the throne would declare the measurement of the bread as a judgement for famine.

Ezek 4:16 Moreover he said unto me, Son of man, behold, **I will break the staff of bread** in Jerusalem: and **they shall eat bread by weight**, and with care; and they shall drink water by measure, and with astonishment:

In the Midst of the four living creatures voice is heard decreeing the Famine.

Rev 6:5 And when he had opened the third seal, I heard the third beast say, Come and see. And I beheld, and lo a black horse; and he that sat on him had a pair of balances in his hand.

**6 And I heard a voice in the midst of the four beasts say, A measure of wheat for a penny, and three measures of barley for a penny; and see thou hurt not the oil and the wine.**

This is Christ in the midst of the four living creatures declaring the judgement of the famine and the measure of bread for the end times.
