

Out of Dust

Prophet John the prophet in sackclothe was a foreshadow what was to come in the end times.

Matt 3:4 And the same John had his raiment of camel's hair, and a leathern girdle about his loins; and his meat was locusts and wild honey.

The disobediant priests and teachers who refused to heed the prophet John were thinking inwardly how they didnt need to listen to the Prophet John because of Abraham.

Matth 3:7 But when he saw many of the Pharisees and Sadducees come to his baptism, he said unto them, O generation of vipers, who hath warned you to flee from the wrath to come?

8 Bring forth therefore fruits meet for repentance:

9 And think not to say within yourselves, We have Abraham to our father: for I say unto you, that **God is able of these stones to raise up children unto Abraham.**

John told them to repent and show the fruit of the repentance to correction and dont try to say inside themselves they have Abraham thinking they are excluded.

John said out of these stones by his feet God can raise up sons of Abraham.

God made man from dust and dust he will return.

Genesis 2:7 And the Lord God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul.

The same will happen in the end.

Christians will come to the prophet in sackclothe and inquire and try to make excuses just like the pharisees and saducees did.

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto my two witnesses, and they shall prophesy a thousand two hundred and threescore days, **clothed in sackcloth.**

They will hear do not make your excuseses... out of this dust God can raise up sons of Jesus.

Rev 11:11 And after three days and an half the **spirit of life from God entered into them, and they stood upon their feet;** and great fear fell upon them which saw them.

Out of the dust and stones of the ground the Resurrection of the Sons of Jesus occurs from the breath of life.

Isaiah 26:19 **Thy dead men shall live, together with my dead body shall they arise.** Awake and sing, **ye that dwell in dust:** for thy dew is as the dew of herbs, and the earth shall cast out the dead.
