

Betrayers and bread.

The foreshadow of Judas and Betrayal of Christ found in Esau.

Esau sold soul for bowl of soup and bread.

Genesis 25:33 And Jacob said, Swear to me this day; and he sware unto him: and he sold his birthright unto Jacob. 34 Then Jacob gave Esau bread and pottage of lentiles; and he did eat and drink, and rose up, and went his way: thus Esau despised his birthright.

Esau betrayed the son of the promise Jacob with a kiss.

Genesis 33:4 and Esau ran to meet him, and embraced him, and fell on his neck, and kissed him: and they wept.

Esau plotted to kill Jacob.

Genesis 27:41 And Esau hated Jacob because of the blessing wherewith his father blessed him: and Esau said in his heart, The days of mourning for my father are at hand; then will I slay my brother Jacob.

It would be better for Esau to never have been born.

Romans 9:11 (For the children being not yet born, neither having done any good or evil, that the purpose of God according to election might stand, not of works, but of him that calleth;)

12 It was said unto her, The elder shall serve the younger. 13 As it is written, Jacob have I loved, but Esau have I hated.

Judas sold his soul for bread and soup dipping into Christ, the Son of the promises bowl.

Mathew 26:23 And he answered and said, He that dippeth his hand with me in the dish, the same shall betray me.

Judas betrayed Christ with a kiss.

Mark 14:44 And he that betrayed him had given them a token, saying, Whomsoever I shall kiss, that same is he; take him, and lead him away safely. 45 And as soon as he was come, he goeth straightway to him, and saith, Master, master; and kissed him.

Judas plotted to have Christ killed.

Matt 27:4 Saying, I have sinned in that I have betrayed the innocent blood. And they said, What is that to us? see thou to that.

5 And he cast down the pieces of silver in the temple, and departed, and went and hanged himself.

It would be better for Judas to never have been born.

Matt 26:24 The Son of man goeth as it is written of him: but woe unto that man by whom the Son of man is betrayed! it had been good for that man if he had not been born.

25 Then Judas, which betrayed him, answered and said, Master, is it I? He said unto him, Thou hast said.

Judas the Betrayer was fulfilled in this same likeness as Esau and the story of Esau foreshadows the betrayal of Christ and the Muslims turning on Christians in end days.

Judas went to perdition.

Jon 17:12 While I was with them in the world, I kept them in thy name: those that thou gavest me I have kept, and none of them is lost, but the son of perdition; that the scripture might be fulfilled.

This is the foreshadow of the likeness of the Antichrist as well in the end times.

Rev 17:11 And the beast that was, and is not, even he is the eighth, and is of the seven, and goeth into perdition.

The son of perdition is the beast. The Muslim mahdi is the beast.

The muslim mahdi is not the son of the promise, Muslims they believe the blessing came through Ishmael not Issaac and they want to kill the sons of the promise in the last days.

Ironically the Book of Jasher shares same comparison about Ishmael and Isaac.

Jasher 21:And when Isaac was five years old he was sitting with Ishmael at the door of the tent. **And Ishmael came to Isaac and seated himself opposite to him**, and he took the bow and drew it and put the arrow in it, and intended **to slay Isaac**.

The Muslims will want to kill just like, like Cain and Abel, like Esau and Jacob, like Ishmael and Issacc and like Judas and Christ.

The bread at the key of this betrayal in the end times is the promise for the blessing.

Rev 2:17 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh **will I give to eat of the hidden manna**, and will give him a white stone, and in the stone a new name written, which no man knoweth saving he that receiveth it.

Those who come with us to the exodus with the bread will inherit the promises.

The muslims mahdi the beast like Esau will want to kill Jacob in this likeness.

They will turn on us over the bread and promise of inheritance.

Rev 12;14 And to the woman were given two wings of a great eagle, that she might fly into the wilderness, into her place, where she is nourished for a time, and times, and half a time, from the face of the serpent.

Their Judas Esau and Cain type will turn on us and kill us..

Rev 11:7 And when they shall have finished their testimony, the beast that ascendeth out of the bottomless pit shall make war against them, and shall overcome them, and kill them.

This is because they are foreshadows of the betrayers and bread written before hand.
