

City of palms

The baptism location of Christ is the city of Palms and Jesus temptation in wilderness.

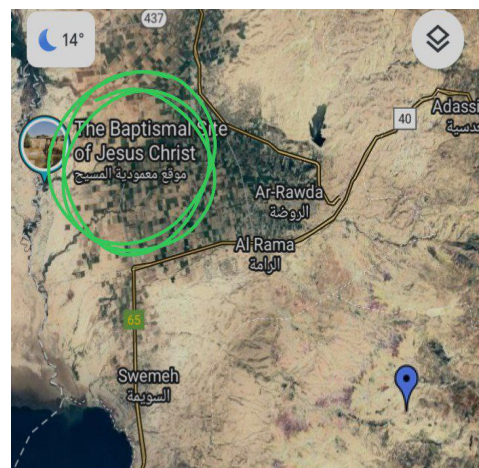
Moses looked over the region where Christ was baptised and the location is explained here

Deut 34:1 And Moses went up from the plains of Moab **unto the mountain of Nebo**, to the top of Pisgah, **that is over against Jericho**. And the Lord shewed him all the land of Gilead, unto Dan,
2 And all Naphtali, and the land of Ephraim, and Manasseh, and all the land of Judah, unto the utmost sea,
3 And the south, and the plain of the valley of Jericho, **the city of palm trees**, unto Zoar.
4 And the Lord said unto him, This is the land which I swear unto Abraham, unto Isaac, and unto Jacob, saying, I will give it unto thy seed: I have caused thee to see it with thine eyes, but thou shalt not go over thither.
5 So Moses the servant of the Lord died there in the land of Moab, according to the word of the Lord.
6 And **he buried him in a valley** in the land of Moab, **over against Bethpeor**: but no man knoweth of his sepulchre unto this day

The city of palm trees is the only location visible from the mountain that Moses was at looking at.

This location is the baptism location of Christ.

The blue dot is the location of the mountain Moses looked over the kingdoms of the world.



This is the location of Christ's baptism with the Date Palms.



The Date Palm is also the symbol of the Kingdom of Christ.

The Tomb of Moses is located at the base of this mountain to the east of Christ baptism.

Deut 34:6 And **he buried him in a valley** in the land of Moab, **over against Bethpeor**: but no man knoweth of his sepulchre unto this day

The location at the base of this mountain is called Nebi Musa and is believed to be the location of the Tomb of Moses.



Christ after being baptised immediatly went EAST into the wilderness.

Matt 3:16 And Jesus, when he was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, lo, the heavens were opened unto him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon him:

17 And lo a voice from heaven, saying, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.

Continues on into next chapter.

Matt 4:4 Then was **Jesus led up of the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted of the devil.**

2 And when **he had fasted forty days and forty nights**, he was afterward an hungred.

3 And when the tempter came to him, he said, If thou be the Son of God, command that these stones be made bread.

We see that Christ went to the location near the tomb of Moses and Satan was there to be tempted.

Moses Fasted forty days and forty nights.

Exodus 34:28 And he was there with the **LORD forty days and forty nights; he did neither eat bread, nor drink water.** And he wrote upon the tables the words of the covenant, the ten commandments.

Christ did the same fast for forty days and forty nights at the tomb of Moses in the wilderness

Matt 4:2 And when **he had fasted forty days and forty nights**, he was afterward an hungred.

3 And when the tempter came to him, he said, If thou be the Son of God, command that these stones be made bread.

This tomb is the same location that Michael contended with Satan over the body of Moses.

Jude 1:9 Yet Michael the archangel, when contending with the devil he disputed about the body of Moses, durst not bring against him a railing accusation, but said, The Lord rebuke thee.

Moses was tempted into sin by satan and this is where moses was forbid to enter the promise land where his body was last.

Deut 32:50 And die in the mount whither thou goest up, and be gathered unto thy people; as Aaron thy brother died in mount Hor, and was gathered unto his people:

51 **Because ye trespassed against me among the children of Israel at the waters of Meribah Kadesh, in the wilderness of Zin;** because ye sanctified me not in the midst of the children of Israel.

52 Yet thou shalt see the land before thee; but thou shalt not go thither unto the land which I give the children of Israel.

Moses was then shown the promise land where he would die because of this.

Deut 34:1 And Moses went up from the plains of Moab **unto the mountain of Nebo**, to the top of Pisgah, **that is over against Jericho**. And the Lord shewed him all the land of Gilead, unto Dan,

2 And all Naphtali, and the land of Ephraim, and Manasseh, and all the land of Judah, unto the utmost sea,

5 So Moses the servant of the Lord died there in the land of Moab, according to the word of the Lord.

Christ was then taken up to the same mountain and shown by devil what Moses saw all the kingdoms offering Christ those kingdoms to worship him.

Matt 4:8 Again, **the devil taketh him up into an exceeding high mountain, and sheweth him all the kingdoms of the world, and the glory of them;**

9 And saith unto him, All these things will I give thee, if thou wilt fall down and worship me.

10 Then saith Jesus unto him, Get thee hence, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve.

11 Then the devil leaveth him, and, behold, angels came and ministered unto him.

The fulfillment of Old Testament for the establishing of New Covenant is found in Christ the same location of His beginning of His ministry where the ministry of Moses ended and left off.

This is the location of the entry of Christ returning to Jerusalem with His armies to cross the Jordan up through Jericho to Jerusalem.
