

Martyrs parade

The Resurrected at the Supper and procession of the Martyrs prophesy.

The book of John 12 and the testimony of Yeshua reveals the prophesy of His return.

The testimony of Yeshua is the Spirit of prophesy.

Rev 19:10 And I fell at his feet to worship him. And he said unto me, See thou do it not: I am thy fellowservant, and of thy brethren that have the testimony of Jesus: worship God: **for the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy.**

The book of John 12 and testimony begins with the Resurrected having a supper.

John 12:1 Then Jesus six days before the passover came to Bethany, where **Lazarus was, which had been dead, whom he raised from the dead.**

2 There they made **him a supper**; and Martha served: but **Lazarus was one of them that sat at the table with him.**

We see that the Resurrected are sitting at the supper.

The next day we see the entering into Jerusalem.

John 12:12 On the next day much people that were come to the feast, when **they heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem,**

13 **Took branches of palm trees**, and went forth to meet him, and cried, Hosanna: Blessed is the King of Israel that cometh in the name of the Lord.

14 And Jesus, when he had found a young ass, sat thereon; as it is written,

15 Fear not, daughter of Sion: behold, **thy King cometh, sitting on an ass's colt.**

We see that people took palm branches and Christ rode in on a horse.

This is all foreshadow story of Christs return.

We see the Resurrected coming to the supper of God.

Rev 19:7 Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honour to him: for the marriage of the Lamb is come, and his wife hath made herself ready.

8 And to **her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white:** for the fine linen is the righteousness of saints.

The Resurrected are wearing white.

9 And he saith unto me, Write, **Blessed are they which are called unto the marriage supper of the Lamb.** And he saith unto me, These are the true sayings of God.

They are called to the Supper of God.

Then we see Christ riding in on a horse.

Rev 19:11 And I saw heaven opened, and behold **a white horse; and he that sat upon him** was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war.

Then we see the return to Jerusalem where Christ places his throne is in the Temple.

Christ takes the temple from the beast.

Rev 19:19 And I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against him that sat on the horse, and against his army.

Christ's procession has the Martyrs with the palm branches just as his procession into Jerusalem.

Rev 7: 9 After this I beheld, and, lo, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, **stood before the throne**, and before the Lamb, **clothed with white robes, and palms in their hands;**

We see the Supper with the Ressurrected and procession into Jerusalem where Kings throne is.

This is the prophesy of the return of Christ in the testimony of Jesus in John 12
