

Burned with fire.

King of babylon burn Jerusalem with fire as a prophetic foreshadow of the end times.

Jer 21:8 And unto this people thou shalt say, Thus saith the Lord; Behold, I set before you the way of life, and the way of death.

9 He that abideth in this city shall die by the sword, and by the famine, and by the pestilence: but he that goeth out, and falleth to the Chaldeans that besiege you, he shall live, and his life shall be unto him for a prey.

10 For I have set my face against this city for evil, and not for good, saith the Lord: it shall be given into the **hand of the king of Babylon, and he shall burn it with fire.**

11 And touching the house of the king of Judah, say, Hear ye the word of the Lord;

12 O house of David, thus saith the Lord; Execute judgment in the morning, and deliver him that is spoiled out of the hand of the oppressor, lest my fury go out like fire, and burn that none can quench it, because of the evil of your doings.

We see the prophetic king of babylon called the beast in the end times.

The beast is who takes jerusalem ruling from it making Jerusalem called Mystery Babylon

Revelation 17 verses show the beast burning jerusalem ith fire.

Revelaton 17:16 And the ten horns which thou sawest upon the beast, these shall hate the whore, and shall make her desolate and naked, and shall eat her flesh, and **burn her with fire.**

17 For **God hath put in their hearts to fulfil his will**, and to agree, and give **their kingdom unto the beast**, until the words of God shall be fulfilled.

18 And the woman which thou sawest is **that great city**, which reigneth over the kings of the earth.

Mystery babylon is the great city in the end times prophesy.

Rev 18:10 Standing afar off for the fear of her torment, saying, Alas, alas that **great city Babylon**, that mighty city! for in one hour is thy judgment come.

Jerusalem is called that great city when Jeremiah saw Jerusalem's desolation.

Jer 22:8 And many nations shall pass by this city, and they shall say every man to his neighbour,  
Wherefore hath the LORD done thus unto **this great city?**

We see that the many nations see the city of Jerusalem burning and say what's done to this great city.

Jerusalem is seen where nations say the same thing about that great city burning with fire.

Rev 18:9 And the kings of the earth, who have committed fornication and lived deliciously with her,  
shall bewail her, and **lament for her, when they shall see the smoke of her burning,**

The word lament is used here to hint at the book of Lamentations.

Lamentations was written about the sacking of Jerusalem by the king of Babylon.

The desolation of Jerusalem in the end times by the beast is seen here where she is burned with fire.

Rev 18:18 And cried when they saw **the smoke of her burning,** saying, What city is like unto this  
**great city!**

This is the king of Babylon burning Jerusalem with fire in the end times.
