

Numbering army

The two accounts of army numberings forshadowing prophesy found in book of Numbers.

The book of numbers shows what will prophetically happen in the end times.

First the numbering of the Soldiers for the camp in the wilderness on the Exodus.

Numbers 1:2 Take ye **the sum of all the congregation of the children of Israel**, after their families, by the house of their fathers, with the number of their names, every male by their polls;

3 From twenty years old and upward, all that are able to go forth to war in Israel: thou and Aaron **shall number them by their armies.**

Then we see latter the sum taken for the taking of the land of Israel for inheritance.

Numbers 26:2 **Take the sum of all the congregation of the children of Israel**, from twenty years old and upward, throughout their fathers' house, all that are able to go to war in Israel.

3 And Moses and Eleazar the priest spake with them in the plains of Moab by Jordan near Jericho, saying,

4 Take the sum of the people, from twenty years old and upward; as the Lord commanded Moses and the children of Israel, which went forth out of the land of Egypt.

Those who rose up to resist moses and aaron were swallowed up by the earth in this mention.

Numbers 26:9 And the sons of Eliab; Nemuel, and Dathan, and Abiram. This is that Dathan and Abiram, which were famous in the congregation, **who strove against Moses and against Aaron** in the company of Korah, when they strove against the Lord:

10 And **the earth opened her mouth, and swallowed them up together with Korah**, when that company died, what time the fire devoured two hundred and fifty men: and they became a sign.

This is also what is to take place in the end.

The numbering of the 144000 armies preparing for the exodus to be the soldiers at the camp.

Rev 7:4 And **I heard the number of them** which were sealed: and there were sealed an hundred and forty and four thousand of all the tribes of the children of Israel.

5 Of the tribe of Juda were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Reuben were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Gad were sealed twelve thousand.

6 Of the tribe of Aser were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Nephthalim were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Manasses were sealed twelve thousand.

7 Of the tribe of Simeon were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Levi were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Issachar were sealed twelve thousand.

8 Of the tribe of Zabulon were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Joseph were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Benjamin were sealed twelve thousand.

This is for the Exodus into the wilderness and the camp to prepare for the retaking of the land of Isreal on Christ return after 42 months.

The exodus has the earth opening mouth swallowing those who resist just like Korah.

Rev 12:14 And to **the woman were given two wings of a great eagle, that she might fly into the wilderness**, into her place, where she is nourished for a time, and times, and half a time, from the face of the serpent.

15 And the serpent cast out of his mouth water as a flood after the woman, that he might cause her to be carried away of the flood.

16 And the **earth helped the woman, and the earth opened her mouth**, and swallowed up the flood which the dragon cast out of his mouth.

Then we see on the Return of Christ the armies taking back from the beast and his armies the land of promise as inheritance for the kingdom of God and His armies.

Rev 19:19 And I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies, **gathered together to make war against him that sat on the horse, and against his army.**

20 And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone.

This is the two numberings for the armies for the Exodus and the taking of the land of inheritance found in the book of numbers that is foreshadow of the end times...
