

Voice of grave.

The voice that calls all alive at Resurrection prophesy.

The foreshadow of whats to come at the Resurrection is seen in the story of Lazarus.

1. We see Christ explaining the death of Lazarus.

John 11:14 Then said Jesus unto them plainly, **Lazarus is dead.**

2. Christ then makes sure its four days that hes dead.

John 11:17 Then when Jesus came, he found that he had lain in the grave **four days already.**

3. Martha explains about the resurrection occuring on the last day.

John 11:23 Jesus saith unto her, Thy brother shall rise again.

24 Martha saith unto him, **I know that he shall rise again in the resurrection at the last day.**

Christ affirms that its after the third day into the fourth day.

John 11:39 Jesus said, Take ye away the stone. Martha, the sister of him that was dead, saith unto him, Lord, by this time he stinketh: for **he hath been dead four days.**

We see Christ with a loud voice says to COME FORTH and the dead come alive.

4. Christ calls with loud voice.

John 11:43 And when he thus had spoken, **he cried with a loud voice, Lazarus, come forth.**

44 And **he that was dead came forth**, bound hand and foot with graveclothes: and his face was bound about with a napkin. Jesus saith unto them, Loose him, and let him go.

Christ again teaching about the graves hearing the voice of Christ and come forth.

John 5:28 Marvel not at this: **for the hour is coming, in the which all that are in the graves shall hear his voice,**

29 **And shall come forth;** they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation.

Now the prophesy.

1. We will be killed and dead as Christ explained like how Lazarus was dead.

Rev 11:7 And when they shall have finished their testimony, the beast that ascendeth out of the bottomless pit shall make war against them, and shall overcome them, and kill them.

8 And **their dead bodies shall lie in the street of the great city**, which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt, where also our Lord was crucified.

2. Christ then makes sure its on the counting of fourth day that were dead.

Rev 11:9 And they of the people and kindreds and tongues and nations shall see their dead bodies **three days and an half**, and shall not suffer their dead bodies to be put in graves.

3. Martha explains about the resurrection occurring on the last day about the end times.

After 1260 days is when the death occurs.

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto my two witnesses, and they shall prophesy **a thousand two hundred and threescore days**, clothed in sackcloth.

1260 days of prophesying then death on the 1260th day.

which gives timing for the last day of Resurrection by 3.5 more days adding to the 1260 days

making the Resurrection on the 1263.5th day.

Rev 11:11 And **after three days and an half the spirit of life from God entered into them, and they stood upon their feet**; and great fear fell upon them which saw them.

4. Christ calls with loud voice.

12 And they **heard a great voice from heaven saying unto them, Come up hither**. And they ascended up to heaven in a cloud; and their enemies beheld them.

This voice calls the dead in graves alive and they stand as Christ is descending to earth.

He calls everyone in the Resurrection to Ascend to him in the cloud as Hes descending to earth.

As the proverb says

Prov 25:6 **Put not forth thyself in the presence of the king**, and stand not in the place of great men:

7 For better it is that it be said unto thee, **Come up hither**; than that thou shouldest be put lower in the presence of the prince whom thine eyes have seen.

The bowl is poured in the air to prepare those who are dead to ascend together to Christ.

Rev 11:17 And **the seventh angel poured out his vial into the air**; and there came a great voice out of the temple of heaven, from the throne, saying, It is done.

This is for the dead to be able to ascend to Christ to meet him in the air as He is descending to earth.

1 Thess 4:16 For **the Lord himself shall descend from heaven** with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and **the dead in Christ shall rise first**:

17 Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, **to meet the Lord in the air**: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.

This verse is referring to the Resurrection.

This is the prophesy of the voice of the grave in the end times

The voice that all hear that calls everyone out of the grave is "COME UP HITHER"
