

Image curse.

I saw the Lord break Islam's back through famines. The muslims began burning their qurans to cook their children to survive. Their cursed book of sin became kindle to cook their own sons and daughters. Just like the days of Elijah when their king who propped up the image of Baal. The curse came on them from Deuteronomy 28 and Leviticus 26 for breaking the commandment of idolatry. The commandment says the punishment will visit the fourth generation on the children and their children's children will become food. The image of jealousy of the image of the beast causes these curses to come in them globally for worshiping the image of the beast. I saw the streets empty no sounds of children playing because they ate all their children. This is why Jesus says woe to those who suck in last days for the great wrath upon this people.

Luke 21: 23 But woe unto them that are with child, and to them that give suck, in those days! for there shall be great distress in the land, and wrath upon this people.

Violation of the commandment to have no images.

Exodus 20:

3 Thou shalt have no other gods before me.

4 Thou shalt not make unto **thee any graven image**, or any likeness of any thing that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth.

5 **Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them**, nor serve them: for I the Lord thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me;

Third and fourth generation of kids become food.

In the days of Elijah they were eating children from the curse and the king was angry when he saw it. He got angry at the prophet and instead of repenting he blamed the prophet.

1 kings 18:17 And it came to pass, when Ahab saw Elijah, that Ahab said unto him, Art thou he that troubleth Israel?

18 And he answered, I have not troubled Israel; but thou, and thy father's house, in that ye have forsaken the commandments of the Lord, and thou hast followed Baalim.

The curse then came from them forsaking the commandments and image of baal.

2 kings 6: 28 And the king said unto her, What aileth thee? And she answered, This woman said unto me, Give thy son, that we may eat him to day, and we will eat my son to morrow.

29 So we boiled my son, and did eat him: and I said unto her on the next day, Give thy son, that we may eat him: and she hath hid her son.

30 And it came to pass, when the king heard the words of the woman, that he rent his clothes; and he passed by upon the wall, and the people looked, and, behold, he had sackcloth within upon his flesh.

31 Then he said, God do so and more also to me, if the head of Elisha the son of Shaphat shall stand on him this day.

This is as it's written.

Leviticus 26:14 But if ye will not hearken unto me, and will not do all these commandments; 15 And if ye shall despise my statutes, or if your soul abhor my judgments, so that ye will not do all my commandments, but that ye break my covenant:

16 I also will do this unto you; I will even appoint over you terror, consumption, and the burning ague, that shall consume the eyes, and cause sorrow of heart: and ye shall sow your seed in vain, for your enemies shall eat it.

27 And if ye will not for all this hearken unto me, but walk contrary unto me;

28 Then I will walk contrary unto you also in fury; and I, even I, will chastise you seven times for your sins.

29 **And ye shall eat the flesh of your sons, and the flesh of your daughters shall ye eat.**

30 **And I will destroy your high places, and cut down your images,** and cast your carcasses upon the carcasses of your idols, and my soul shall abhor you.

31 And I will make your cities waste, and bring your sanctuaries unto desolation, and I will not smell the savour of your sweet odours.

32 And I will bring the land into desolation: and your enemies which dwell therein shall be astonished at it.

You will eat your children and land will become desolate. The abomination that makes desolation does this with the image of the beast.

leviticus 26:29 and ye shall eat the flesh of your sons, and the flesh of your daughters shall ye eat.

And animals eating the children curse.

Leviticus 26: 22 I will also send **wild beasts among you, which shall rob you of your children,** and destroy your cattle, and make you few in number; and your high ways shall be desolate.

2 kings 2:23 And he went up from thence unto Bethel: and as he was going up by the way, there came forth little children out of the city, and mocked him, and said unto him, Go up, thou bald head; go up, thou bald head.

24 And he turned back, and looked on them, and cursed them in the name of the Lord. And there came forth **two she bears out of the wood, and tare forty and two children of them.**

The curse of Deuteronomy 28 to sack Jerusalem causing them to be desolate and eat their children'.

Deut 28:49 The Lord shall bring a nation against thee from far, from the end of the earth, as swift as the eagle flieth; a nation whose tongue thou shalt not understand;

50 A nation of fierce countenance, which shall not regard the person of the old, nor shew favour to the young:

51 And he shall eat the fruit of thy cattle, and the fruit of thy land, until thou be destroyed: which

also shall not leave thee either corn, wine, or oil, or the increase of thy kine, or flocks of thy sheep, until he have destroyed thee.

52 And he shall besiege thee in all thy gates, until thy high and fenced walls come down, wherein thou trustedst, throughout all thy land: and he shall besiege thee in all thy gates throughout all thy land, which the Lord thy God hath given thee.

53 And **thou shalt eat the fruit of thine own body, the flesh of thy sons and of thy daughters**, which the Lord thy God hath given thee, in the siege, and in the straitness, wherewith thine enemies shall distress thee:

54 So that the man that is tender among you, and very delicate, his eye shall be evil toward his brother, and toward the wife of his bosom, and toward the remnant of his children which he shall leave:

55 So that **he will not give to any of them of the flesh of his children whom he shall eat**: because he hath nothing left him in the siege, and in the straitness, wherewith thine enemies shall distress thee in all thy gates.

56 The tender and delicate woman among you, which would not adventure to set the sole of her foot upon the ground for delicateness and tenderness, her eye shall be evil toward the husband of her bosom, and toward her son, and toward her daughter,

57 And toward her young one that cometh out from between her feet, and toward her children which she shall bear: **for she shall eat them** for want of all things secretly in the siege and straitness, wherewith thine enemy shall distress thee in thy gates.

The abomination of desolation is the image of jealousy known as the image of the beast.

Ezek 8:3 And he put forth the form of an hand, and took me by a lock of mine head; and the spirit lifted me up between the earth and the heaven, and brought me in the visions of God to Jerusalem, to the door of the inner gate that looketh toward the north; where was the seat of **the image of jealousy**, which provoketh to jealousy.

Abomination that makes desolate. The curse of the armies to stop sacrifices and transgression of desolation.

Dan 8:12 And an host was given him against the daily sacrifice by reason of transgression, and it cast down the truth to the ground; and it practised, and prospered.

13 Then I heard one saint speaking, and another saint said unto that certain saint which spake, How long shall be the vision concerning the daily sacrifice, and **the transgression of desolation**, to give both the sanctuary and **the host to be trodden under foot**?

The abomination that causes desolation.

Dan 11:31 And arms shall stand on his part, and they shall pollute the sanctuary of strength, and shall take away the daily sacrifice, and **they shall place the abomination that maketh desolate**.

The abomination of desolation.

Daniel 12:11 And from the time that the daily sacrifice shall be taken away, and **the abomination that maketh desolate set up**, there shall be a thousand two hundred and ninety days.

The abomination of desolation is mentioned where Jesus refers to saying woe to those who suck in those days when you see the abomination of desolation. He says at this time flee to Petra.

Mark 13: 14 But when **ye shall see the abomination of desolation**, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing where it ought not, (let him that readeth understand,) then **let them that be in Judaea flee to the mountains:**

15 And let him that is on the housetop not go down into the house, neither enter therein, to take any thing out of his house:

16 And let him that is in the field not turn back again for to take up his garment.

17 But **woe to them that are with child, and to them that give suck in those days!**

You will see the armies to come in surroundings at the abomination of desolation.

Luke 21:20 And when ye shall see Jerusalem compassed with armies, then know that **the desolation thereof is nigh.**

21 Then let them which are in Judaea flee to the mountains; and let them which are in the midst of it depart out; and let not them that are in the countries enter thereinto.

The desolation is near.. woe to those who suck with children in those days they will eat their children.

Matt 24:15 When ye therefore shall **see the abomination of desolation**, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, stand in the holy place, (whoso readeth, let him understand:)

16 Then let them which be in **Judaea flee into the mountains:**

17 Let him which is on the housetop not come down to take any thing out of his house:

18 Neither let him which is in the field return back to take his clothes.

19 And **woe unto them that are with child, and to them that give suck in those days!**

Woe to those with children... They set up the image of the beast the abomination of desolation.

The curse of desolation mentioned prior.

Leviticus 26:31 And I will make your cities waste, and **bring your sanctuaries unto desolation**, and I will not smell the savour of your sweet odours. 32 And I will bring the land into desolation: and your enemies which dwell therein shall be astonished at it.

Image of the beast makes desolation

Rev 13:14 And deceiveth them that dwell on the earth by the means of those miracles which he had power to do in the sight of the beast; saying to them that dwell on the earth, that **they should make an image to the beast**, which had the wound by a sword, and did live.

15 And he had power to give life unto **the image of the beast**, that the **image of the beast** should both speak, and cause that as many as would not worship the image of the beast should be killed.

Woe to them who worship the image of the beast for they will be smitten with a curse world wide to eat their own children and the land will be desolate.

The curse and the Saviour.

Isaiah 49:26 And **I will feed them that oppress thee with their own flesh**; and they shall be drunken with their own blood, as with sweet wine: and all flesh shall know that I the Lord am thy Saviour and thy Redeemer, the mighty One of Jacob.

Isaiah 9:19 Through the wrath of the Lord of hosts is the land darkened, and the people shall be as the fuel of the fire: no man shall spare his brother.

20 And he shall snatch on the right hand, and be hungry; and **he shall eat on the left hand, and they shall not be satisfied: they shall eat every man the flesh of his own arm:**

selling of children.

Joel 3:3 And they have cast lots for my people; and have given a boy for an harlot, and sold a girl for wine, that they might drink.

The death will come and cutt children off the streets.

Jer 9:21 For **death has climbed in through our windows**; it has entered our fortresses **to cut off the children from the streets**, the young men from the town squares.

They will be made desolate and eat their own children.

Jer 19: And I will make void the counsel of Judah and Jerusalem in this place; and I will cause them to fall by the sword before their enemies, and by the hands of them that seek their lives: and their carcasses will I give to be meat for the fowls of the heaven, and for the beasts of the earth.

8 And **I will make this city desolate**, and an hissing; every one that passeth thereby shall be astonished and hiss because of all the plagues thereof.

9 And **I will cause them to eat the flesh of their sons and the flesh of their daughters**, and they shall eat every one the flesh of his friend in the siege and straitness, wherewith their enemies, and they that seek their lives, shall straiten them.

Eating the children warning has long been known before for the desolation.

Ezek 5:9 And I will do in thee that which I have not done, and whereunto I will not do any more the like, because of all thine abominations.

10 Therefore **the fathers shall eat the sons in the midst of thee, and the sons shall eat their fathers;** and I will execute judgments in thee, and the whole remnant of thee will I scatter into all the winds.

11 Wherefore, as I live, saith the Lord God; Surely, because thou hast defiled my sanctuary with all thy detestable things, and with all thine abominations, therefore will I also diminish thee; neither shall mine eye spare, neither will I have any pity.

In the sacking of Babylon the eating of children was seen.

Lam 2:11 Mine eyes do fail with tears, my bowels are troubled, my liver is poured upon the earth, for the destruction of the daughter of my people; because **the children and the sucklings swoon in the streets of the city.**

12 They say to their mothers, Where is corn and wine? when they swooned as the wounded in the streets of the city, when their soul was poured out into their mothers' bosom.

Eating thier own children.

Lam 2:19 Arise, cry out in the night: in the beginning of the watches pour out thine heart like water before the face of the Lord: lift up thy hands toward him **for the life of thy young children, that faint for hunger in the top of every street.**

20 Behold, O Lord, and consider to whom thou hast done this. **Shall the women eat their fruit,** and children of a span long? shall the priest and the prophet be slain in the sanctuary of the Lord?

The desolation and eating thier own children.

Lam 4:10 The hands of the pitiful **women have sodden their own children:** they were their meat in the destruction of the daughter of my people.

11 The Lord hath accomplished his fury; he hath poured out his fierce anger, and hath kindled a fire in Zion, and it hath devoured the foundations thereof.

The rains will be withheld for those years creating famines and dry trees so they will eat their children. This is why Christ said if they are wicked now what will they do when its dry from drought and famines... notice he says weep for your children.

Luke 23:28 But Jesus turning unto them said, Daughters of Jerusalem, weep not for me, but weep for yourselves, and **for your children.**

29 For, behold, the days are coming, in the which they shall say, **Blessed are the barren, and the wombs that never bare, and the paps which never gave suck.**

30 Then shall they begin to say to the mountains, Fall on us; and to the hills, Cover us.

31 For if they do these things in a green tree, **what shall be done in the dry?**

If they kill the messiah during a time of rain what will they do to their own children during the time of a famine and drought...

They will eat their children..

This is the curse the world will face for the image of the beast.
