

The composition of the Quran and the Errors.

The historical claims of the Quran can be disproven by simple facts.

According to museum historians.

Muslims believe that the Qur'an, the holy book of Islam, was revealed to Muhammad over a period of twenty-three years, starting with the initial revelation at Mount Hira.

After the Prophet's death, his successors compiled these divine revelations in a manuscript.

1. Mohamed could not read or write according to claims of illiteracy of Mohamed.

We know that Mohamed himself did not write the Quran.

Zāyd bin Thābit bin al-Ḍaḥḥāk was the personal scribe of the Islamic prophet Muhammad, serving as the chief recorder of the Quranic text.

The problem with this is the Quran hadnt been written yet... If this came as a revelation there would have been no writings at that time to refer too.. because the Quran had not been compiled.

It at this time still would have been a revelation and there would be no writings for people who were hearing this to find any inconsistencies in because the Qurans composition had not occurred until after mohamed died.

This is not isolated in the statements again we see that at the time of mohamed this would not have been possible for people to verify claim because absence of the writings.

Again the time of this "revelation" there was no book, the quran had not been written and people could not contemplate the verses until AFTER mohamed had died because Zayd had not compiled the Quran...

We know that it is clear that these statements were ADDED at the time of the compiling of the Quran to give itself credence in claims of the revelation. Of course you cant Question the original manuscripts because.. well... they were all destroyed... there contains no original copies of these claims...

What this is tho, is a late after the fact writing created to uphold a movement founded by Aishas husband and compiled by her father after her husband mohamed died... which means you just have to trust mohameds family had good intentions and that they wouldnt dare make up stories to glorify their own daughters husband to keep the movement going.

The Birmingham Quran manuscript is a single sheet of parchment on which two leaves of an early Quranic manuscript or mushaf have been written. In 2015, the manuscript, which is held by the University of Birmingham, was radiocarbon dated to between **568 and 645 CE** (in the Islamic calendar, between 56 before Hijrah and 24 after Hijrah)
