

## Psalm 22 Christ

The Error of Islam and prophesy of Psalm 22 in end times.

Muslims argue Christ cannot be God because Christ cried out to God on the cross.

This comes from Muslims not realizing that Psalm 22 is prophesy that Christ was quoting to show people in his audience at the time that He was fulfilling prophesy.

The statement is made from this verse.

Matt 27:45 Now from the sixth hour there was darkness over all the land unto the ninth hour.  
46 And about the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, saying, Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani? that is to say, My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me?

This is clearly Christ quoting Psalm 22.. but why?

Look to what occurred in verses prior... they were mocking Him before he Quoted Psalm 22.

Matt 27:39 And they that passed by reviled him, **wagging their heads,**

40 And saying, Thou that destroyest the temple, and buildest it in three days, save thyself. If thou be the Son of God, come down from the cross.

41 Likewise also **the chief priests mocking him,** with the scribes and elders, said,

42 He saved others; himself he cannot save. If he be the King of Israel, let him now come down from the cross, and we will believe him.

43 **He trusted in God; let him deliver him now,** if he will have him: for he said, I am the Son of God.

He then quotes Psalm 22 which the whole chapter is prophesy.

Psalm 22:1 My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me? why art thou so far from helping me, and from the words of my roaring?

The prophesy of them mocking him saying the same words from the chief priests is in Psalm 22.

Psalm 22:6 But I am a worm, and no man; **a reproach of men, and despised of the people.**

7 All they that see me **laugh me to scorn: they shoot out the lip, they shake the head,** saying,

8 **He trusted on the Lord that he would deliver him: let him deliver him,** seeing he delighted in him.

But not just this fulfillment of prophesy in Psalm 22 it continues.

Psalm 22:14 I am poured out like water, and all my bones are out of joint: my heart is like wax; it is melted in the midst of my bowels.

He was poured out like water.

John 19:34 But one of the soldiers with a spear pierced his side, and forthwith came there out blood and water.

His tongue cleaved to his jaws

Psalm 22:15 My strength is dried up like a potsherd; and my tongue cleaveth to my jaws; and thou hast brought me into the dust of death.

So they fed him vinegar to drink.

Matt 27:48 And straightway one of them ran, and took a sponge, and filled it with vinegar, and put it on a reed, and gave him to drink.

The prophesy says they would part his garments... and cast lots..

Psalm 22:18 They part my garments among them, and cast lots upon my vesture.

This was what occurred and told to be a prophesy of prophet.

Matt 27:35 And they crucified him, and parted his garments, casting lots: that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet, They parted my garments among them, and upon my vesture did they cast lots.

They crucified him ... piercing his hands and his feet...

Psalm 22:16 For dogs have compassed me: the assembly of the wicked have inclosed me: **they pierced my hands and my feet.**

They stood around him many bulls of bashan

Psalm 22:12 Many bulls have compassed me: strong bulls of Bashan have beset me round.  
13 They gaped upon me with their mouths, as a ravening and a roaring lion.

This bulls of bashan is a term about soldiers... that surrounded him at his crucifixion.

They try it again on his return but not with the same result.

Here is the bulls of bashan surrounding him on His return... which are armies and soldiers...

Ezekiel 39:17 And, thou son of man, thus saith the Lord God; Speak unto every feathered fowl, and to every beast of the field, Assemble yourselves, and come; gather yourselves on every side to my sacrifice that I do sacrifice for you, even a great sacrifice upon the mountains of Israel, that ye may eat flesh, and drink blood.

18 Ye shall eat the flesh of the mighty, and drink the blood of the princes of the earth, of rams, of lambs, and of goats, of bullocks, **all of them fatlings of Bashan.**

19 And ye shall eat fat till ye be full, and drink blood till ye be drunken, of my sacrifice which I have sacrificed for you.

20 Thus ye shall be filled at my table with **horses and chariots, with mighty men, and with all men of war,** saith the Lord God.

21 And I will set my glory among the heathen, and all the heathen shall see my judgment that I have executed, and my hand that I have laid upon them.

22 So the house of Israel shall know that I am the Lord their God from that day and forward.

House of Israel will know Him from that day forward..

The Muslims armies turning to fight Christ.... and the fulfillment of this prophesy.

Rev 19:17 And I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the fowls that fly in the midst of heaven, Come and gather yourselves together unto the supper of the great God;

18 That ye may eat the flesh of kings, and the **flesh of captains, and the flesh of mighty men**, and the flesh of horses, and of them that sit on them, and the flesh of all men, both free and bond, both small and great.

19 And I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against him that sat on the horse, and against his army.

On his return the whole earth will remember and mourn.... and worship Christ.

Psalm 22:27 All the ends of the world shall remember and turn unto the Lord: and all the kindreds of the nations **shall worship before thee**.

Rev 1:7 Behold, he cometh with clouds; and every eye shall see him, and **they also which pierced him: and all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of him**. Even so, Amen.

On that day the Resurrection will occur just like after they pierced him...

Zech 12:10 And I will pour upon the house of David, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the spirit of grace and of supplications: and **they shall look upon me whom they have pierced, and they shall mourn for him, as one mourneth for his only son**, and shall be in bitterness for him, as one that is in bitterness for his firstborn.

He will rule the earth on that Day.

Rev 11:15 And the seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are **become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of his Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever**.

Which is fulfillment of prophesy of Psalm 22:

PSalm 22:28 For the kingdom is the Lord's: and he is the governor among the nations.

Everyone who dies shall bow and worship before Him...

Psalm 22:27 All the ends of the world shall remember and turn unto the Lord: and all the kindreds of the nations **shall worship before thee**.

Psalm 22:29 All they that be fat upon earth shall eat and worship: **all they that go down to the dust shall bow before him**: and none can keep alive his own soul.

Everyone will bow before the Son of God and worship Him...

Its prophesy of the Psalm 22 in the end times...
