

The prophesy of being running away naked in shame of the end times.

From the beginning of Genesis there was a prophetic warning of the end times..

That you must be clothed with the lamb so you dont run away naked and be seen in your shame when the Lord comes.

Gen 3:8 And **they heard the voice of the Lord God walking in the garden in the cool of the day:** and **Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the Lord God** amongst the trees of the garden.

The Lord came at an hour they did not expect and they ran away naked and hid themselves..

Gen 3:9 And the Lord God called unto Adam, and said unto him, Where art thou?

Gen 3:10 And he said, I heard thy voice in the garden, and **I was afraid, because I was naked;** and I hid myself.

Gen 3:11 And he said, Who told thee that thou wast naked? Hast thou eaten of the tree, whereof I commanded thee that thou shouldest not eat?

So they were naked and God clothed them with the Lamb.

Gen 3:21 Unto Adam also and to his wife did **the Lord God make coats of skins, and clothed them.**

This prophetic warning is seen again during the time of Christ.

Christ was like Adam in the Garden when the Soldiers came like a thief in the night... the man who was unprepared fled naked and they saw his shame.

Mark 14:48 And Jesus answered and said unto them, **Are ye come out, as against a thief,** with swords and with staves to take me?

Mark 14:49 I was daily with you in the temple teaching, and ye took me not: but the scriptures must be fulfilled.

Mark 14:50 And they all forsook him, and **fled.**

Mark 14:51 And there followed him a certain young man, having a linen cloth cast about his naked body; and the young men laid hold on him:

52 And he left the linen cloth, **and fled from them naked.**

They came as a thief in the night in the garden and a man fled naked and they saw his shame.

This prophetic warning is alluding to how Christ will return likewise at an unexpected hour...

Christ gives warning to the lukewarm Church that they better be clothed with the LAMB.

Rev 3:17 Because thou sayest, I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing; and knowest not that thou art wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, **and naked:**

18 I counsel thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich; and **white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, and that the shame of thy nakedness do not appear;** and anoint thine eyes with eyesalve, that thou mayest see.

And what are they clothed with? With the blood of the Lamb...

Rev 7:14 And I said unto him, Sir, thou knowest. And he said to me, These are they which came out of great tribulation, and have washed **their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.**

The Lord returning as a thief in the night to take vengeance... is a clear warning and to make sure people are not naked but clothed with the Lamb like Adam.

The warning of the prophesy of the end

Isa 47:3 **Thy nakedness shall be uncovered, yea, thy shame shall be seen: I will take vengeance, and I will not meet thee as a man.**

The revelation of the end when He comes as a thief for vengeance they flee and hide themselves..

Rev 6:15 And the kings of the earth, and the great men, and the rich men, and the chief captains, and the mighty men, and every bondman, and every free man, **hid themselves** in the dens and in the rocks of the mountains;

the day of the LORD..

Isa 2:10 **Enter into the rock, and hide thee in the dust,** for fear of the Lord, and for the glory of his majesty.

Isa 2:19 And they shall go into the holes of the rocks, and into the caves of the earth, for fear of the Lord, and for the glory of his majesty, when he ariseth to shake terribly the earth.

They are running naked and hide themselves from the presence of the Lord just like Adam...

When I closed my eyes... I saw the vision men in military uniforms fleeing taking their cammies off running away naked.. They were trying to not be caught in military clothes on that day as they fled away naked to hide.

Amos 2:

16 And he that is courageous among the mighty shall flee away naked in that day, saith the Lord.

Rev 16:15 Behold, **I come as a thief.** Blessed is he that watcheth, and **keepeth his garments, lest he walk naked, and they see his shame.**

This is the prophesy found in Genesis of the end times.

Those who are clothed with the Lamb wont run away naked and be seen with thier shame when the presence of the Lord comes to walk the earth at an hour unexpected...

The prophesy of being running away naked in shame.
