

Jerusalem will drink of the cup of wrath.

She was drunk with the blood of the saints.

The best wine is for last.

The woman will be made drunk by the wine from winepress of blood up to a horse's bridle.

Because they are drunk from shed bloods of saints in their winepress, the Lord gives them blood to drink in His winepress.

Rev 16: 5 And I heard the angel of the waters say, Thou art righteous, O Lord, which art, and wast, and shalt be, because thou hast judged thus.

6 For they have shed the blood of saints and prophets, and thou hast given them blood to drink; for they are worthy.

Woman drunk with blood of saints.

Rev 17:6 And I saw the woman drunken with the blood of the saints, and with the blood of the martyrs of Jesus: and when I saw her, I wondered with great admiration.

The kings of the earth were drinking of this blood of saints through the fornication of the image of the beast.

Rev 17: 2 With whom the kings of the earth have committed fornication, and the inhabitants of the earth have been made drunk with the wine of her fornication.

They are killing Christians who wouldnt worship.

Rev 13: 14 And deceiveth them that dwell on the earth by the means of those miracles which he had power to do in the sight of the beast; saying to them that dwell on the earth, that they should make an image to the beast, which had the wound by a sword, and did live.

15 And he had power to give life unto the image of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak, and cause that as many as would not worship the image of the beast should be killed.

The first wine she's drinking but the Lord has saved the best wine for last for the wedding.

John 2: 9 When the ruler of the feast had tasted the water that was made wine, and knew not whence it was: (but the servants which drew the water knew;) the governor of the feast called the bridegroom,

10 And saith unto him, Every man at the beginning doth set forth good wine; and when men have well drunk, then that which is worse: but thou hast kept the good

Now the best wine for her cup.

Rev 16: 19 And the great city was divided into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell: and great Babylon came in remembrance before God, to give unto her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of his wrath.

The cup of the wine of wrath found in Isaiah 63:1-8

First we see the treading of winepress to make them drunk.

Isaiah 63:6 And I will tread down the people in mine anger, and make them drunk in my fury, and I will bring down their strength to the earth.

Now the full context.

Isaiah 63:1 Who is this that cometh from Edom, with dyed garments from Bozrah? this that is glorious in his apparel, travelling in the greatness of his strength? I that speak in righteousness, mighty to save.

2 Wherefore art thou red in thine apparel, and thy garments like him that treadeth in the winefat?

3 I have trodden the winepress alone; and of the people there was none with me: for I will tread them in mine anger, and trample them in my fury; and their blood shall be sprinkled upon my garments, and I will stain all my raiment.

4 For the day of vengeance is in mine heart, and the year of my redeemed is come.

5 And I looked, and there was none to help; and I wondered that there was none to uphold: therefore mine own arm brought salvation unto me; and my fury, it upheld me.

6 And I will tread down the people in mine anger, and make them drunk in my fury, and I will bring down their strength to the earth.

The winepress cup warning.

Rev 14: 10 The same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out without mixture into the cup of his indignation; and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb:

Now the winepress.

Rev 14: 14 And I looked, and behold a white cloud, and upon the cloud one sat like unto the Son of man, having on his head a golden crown, and in his hand a sharp sickle.

15 And another angel came out of the temple, crying with a loud voice to him that sat on the cloud, Thrust in thy sickle, and reap: for the time is come for thee to reap; for the harvest of the earth is ripe.

16 And he that sat on the cloud thrust in his sickle on the earth; and the earth was reaped.

17 And another angel came out of the temple which is in heaven, he also having a sharp sickle.

18 And another angel came out from the altar, which had power over fire; and cried with a loud cry to him that had the sharp sickle, saying, Thrust in thy sharp sickle, and gather the clusters of the vine of the earth; for her grapes are fully ripe.

19 And the angel thrust in his sickle into the earth, and gathered the vine of the earth, and cast it into the great winepress of the wrath of God.

20 And the winepress was trodden without the city, and blood came out of the winepress, even unto the horse bridles, by the space of a thousand and six hundred furlongs.

More of the Winepress He is clothed in raiment stained with blood.

Rev 19: 13 And he was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and his name is called The Word of God.

Rev 19: 15 And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

This is the promise of the Messiah from Genesis.

Genesis 49: 9 Judah is a lion's whelp: from the prey, my son, thou art gone up: he stooped down, he couched as a lion, and as an old lion; who shall rouse him up?

10 The sceptre shall not depart from Judah, nor a lawgiver from between his feet, until Shiloh come; and unto him shall the gathering of the people be.

11 Binding his foal unto the vine, and his ass's colt unto the choice vine; he washed his garments in wine, and his clothes in the blood of grapes:

12 His eyes shall be red with wine, and his teeth white with milk.

The guilt of Jerusalem and her blood of the righteous.

Jerusalem is Babylon.

Rev 18:20 Rejoice over her, thou heaven, and ye holy apostles and prophets; for God hath avenged you on her.

Blood of the apostles and prophets.

Rev 18: 24 And in her was found the blood of prophets, and of saints, and of all that were slain upon the earth.

And all the righteous of the earth including Abel. Jerusalem was the location of the Garden of Eden.

Matt 23: 30 And say, If we had been in the days of our fathers, we would not have been partakers with them in the blood of the prophets.

31 Wherefore ye be witnesses unto yourselves, that ye are the children of them which killed the prophets.

Matt 23: 34 Wherefore, behold, I send unto you prophets, and wise men, and scribes: and some of them ye shall kill and crucify; and some of them shall ye scourge in your synagogues, and persecute them from city to city:

35 That upon you may come all the righteous blood shed upon the earth, from the blood of righteous Abel unto the blood of Zacharias son of Barachias, whom ye slew between the temple and the altar.

36 Verily I say unto you, All these things shall come upon this generation.

37 O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, thou that killest the prophets, and stonest them which are sent unto thee, how often would I have gathered thy children together, even as a hen gathereth her chickens under her wings, and ye would not!

38 Behold, your house is left unto you desolate.

The drinking of the cup of the wine of wrath is fair.. because the wine that was made of Christ...

Rev 16: 19 And the great city was divided into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell: and great Babylon came in remembrance before God, **to give unto her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of his wrath.**

In this cup is given wine of the fierceness of his wrath.

Rev 14: 10 The same **shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God**, which is poured out without mixture **into the cup of his indignation**; and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb:

That cup that's filled with the wine from winepress of wrath...

Rev 19: 15 And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: **and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.**

Is it not just ? For the unjust wrath placed on Christ he drank ? He drank of this cup and we too?

Matt 20:22 But Jesus answered and said, Ye know not what ye ask. **Are ye able to drink of the cup that I shall drink of**, and to be baptized with the baptism that I am baptized with? They say unto him, We are able.

23 And he saith unto them, **Ye shall drink indeed of my cup**, and be baptized with the baptism that I am baptized with: but to sit on my right hand, and on my left, is not mine to give, but it shall be given to them for whom it is prepared of my Father.

And what cup did Christ drink? The cup of shedding of blood...

Matt 26:27 And **he took the cup**, and gave thanks, and gave it to them, saying, Drink ye all of it;

28 For **this is my blood** of the new testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins.

29 But I say unto you, **I will not drink henceforth of this fruit of the vine, until that day when I drink it new with you in my Father's kingdom.**

In the winepress of the wrath of God the wine is made of the vine of the earth... we share in this wine with Him on His return making the river of wine....

Jerusalem will drink of the cup of wrath as retribution for making Christ drink of the wine of wrath.
