

The sign of Samson in the end times.

Samson prophetically is foreshadowing the prophet to come.

Judges 13:3 And the angel of the Lord appeared unto the woman, and said unto her, Behold now, thou art barren, and bearest not: but thou shalt conceive, and bear a son.

4 Now therefore beware, I pray thee, and drink not wine nor strong drink, and eat not any unclean thing:

5 For, lo, thou shalt conceive, and bear a son; and no razor shall come on his head: for the child shall be a Nazarite unto God from the womb: and **he shall begin to deliver Israel** out of the hand of the Philistines.

6 Then the woman came and told her husband, saying, A man of God came unto me, and his countenance was like the countenance of an angel of God, very terrible: but I asked him not whence he was, neither told he me his name:

7 But he said unto me, Behold, thou shalt conceive, and bear a son; and now drink no wine nor strong drink, neither eat any unclean thing: **for the child shall be a Nazarite to God from the womb to the day of his death.**

1. The Nazarite will deliver Israel out of the hand of thier enemies and will be nazarite until his death.

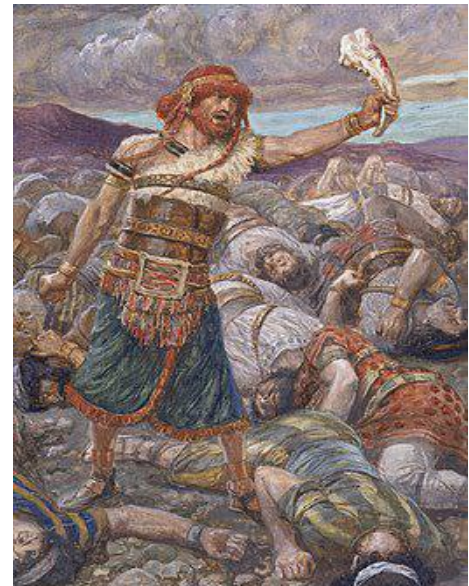
2. This Nazarite took a Jawbone of an ass and slain the enemies with an axe like weapon.

Judges 15: (KJV)

15 And he found a new jawbone of an ass, and put forth his hand, and took it, and slew a thousand men therewith.

16 And Samson said, With the jawbone of an ass, heaps upon heaps, with the jaw of an ass have I slain a thousand men.

The jawbone of an ass handled is like an Axe.



3. The Nazarite during time of thirst for water inquired and water miraculously was provided.

Judges 15: (KJV)

18 And **he was sore athirst, and called on the Lord**, and said, Thou hast given this great deliverance into the hand of thy servant: and **now shall I die for thirst**, and fall into the hand of the uncircumcised?

19 But **God clave an hollow place that was in the jaw, and there came water thereout**; and when he had drunk, his spirit came again, and he revived: wherefore he called the name thereof Enhakkore, which is in Lehi unto this day.

4. The Nazarite fed others with the honey from the belly of the lion...

Judges 14:(KJV)

8And after a time he returned to take her, and he turned aside to see the carcase of the lion: and, behold, there was a swarm of bees and **honey in the carcase of the lion**.

9 And **he took thereof in his hands, and went on eating, and came to his father and mother, and he gave them, and they did eat**: but he told not them that **he had taken the honey out of the carcase of the lion**.

5.The Nazarite went to the harlot.

Judges 16:1 Then went **Samson** to Gaza, and saw there an harlot, and went in unto her.

6. This Nazarite will be a martyr.

Judges 16:29 And Samson took hold of the two middle pillars upon which the house stood, and on which it was borne up, of the one with his right hand, and of the other with his left.

30 And Samson said, Let me die with the Philistines. And he bowed himself with all his might; and the house fell upon the lords, and upon all the people that were therein. So the dead which he slew at his death were more than they which he slew in his life.

1.This nazarite prophet will deliver Gods people for the 1260 days.

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto my two witnesses, and they shall prophesy a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

Rev 12:6 And the woman fled into the wilderness, where she hath a place prepared of God, that they should feed her there a thousand two hundred and threescore days.

2. This prophet has power to slay people with an axe.

Rev 11:5 And if any man will hurt them, fire proceedeth out of their mouth, and devoureth their enemies: and **if any man will hurt them, he must in this manner be killed**.

3. During the time of thirst the Nazarite prophet will inquire and and water will miraculously come.

Rev 11:6 **These have power to shut heaven, that it rain not in the days of their prophecy:** and have power over waters to turn them to blood, and to smite the earth with all plagues, as often as they will.

4. The Nazarite will feed others with honey from the belly of the lion.

The Lion has the book from out of his mouth which comes from his belly.

Rev 5:5 And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: behold, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, hath prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof.

This book is told to be eaten by the Lion voice from heaven. (out of his mouth from belly)

Rev 10:8 And **the voice which I heard from heaven spake unto me again**, and said, Go and take the little book which is open in the hand of the angel which standeth upon the sea and upon the earth.

9 And I went unto the angel, and said unto him, Give me the little book. And he said unto me, **Take it, and eat it up; and it shall make thy belly bitter, but it shall be in thy mouth sweet as honey.**

10 And I took the little book out of the angel's hand, and ate it up; and **it was in my mouth sweet as honey:** and as soon as I had eaten it, my belly was bitter.

This honey was shared with others...

Rev 10:11 And he said unto me, Thou must prophesy again before many peoples, and nations, and tongues, and kings.

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto my two witnesses, and they shall prophesy a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

5. The Nazarite went to the harlot.

Jerusalem is the Harlot that great city.

Rev 17:5 And upon her forehead was a name written, Mystery, **Babylon The Great**, The Mother Of Harlots And Abominations Of The Earth.

Jerusalem is where the Lord was crucified.

Rev 11:8 And their dead bodies shall lie in the street of the great city, which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt, **where also our Lord was crucified.**

6. The Nazarite will be a Martyr.

Rev 11:7 And when they shall have finished their testimony, the beast that ascendeth out of the bottomless pit shall make war against them, and **shall overcome them, and kill them.**
