

The blind begger prophesy of the end times.

The Lord saw a poor blind begger and he healed his sight.

John 9:5-8 (KJV)

5 As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world.

6 When he had thus spoken, he spat on the ground, and made clay of the spittle, and **he anointed the eyes of the blind man** with the clay,

7 And said unto him, Go, wash in the pool of Siloam, (which is by interpretation, Sent.) He went his way therefore, and washed, and came seeing.

8 The neighbours therefore, and they which before had seen him that he was blind, said, Is not this he that sat and begged?

The parable of the blind mind is given to the warning to the Church of Laodicea.

Rev 3:15 I know thy works, that thou art neither cold nor hot: I would thou wert cold or hot.

16 So then because thou art lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spue thee out of my mouth.

The likeness to the blindman is used in explaining the need to have thier eyes anointed...

Revelation 3:17-18 (KJV)

17 Because thou sayest, I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing; and knowest not that thou art wretched, and miserable, and **poor, and blind**, and naked:

18 I counsel thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich; and white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, and that the shame of thy nakedness do not appear; and **anoint thine eyes with eyesalve, that thou mayest see.**

For those who refuse to hear the warning of the parable and say they can see... your sin like the pharisees remains...

John 9:39 And Jesus said, For judgment I am come into this world, that they which see not might see; and that they which see might be made blind.

40 And some of the Pharisees which were with him heard these words, and said unto him, Are we blind also?

41 Jesus said unto them, If ye were blind, ye should have no sin: **but now ye say, We see; therefore your sin remaineth.**

The religious leaders thought they could see refusing to repent because they thought they could see also. Their sin remained unto condemnation for them..

What happened during the first coming of Christ occurs in the second coming also..

The same is in the end times Church... you can be a pharisees or accept you are a blind man..
