

Falling figs.

Christ talked about cursing the figs as of great faith and it will be done

Christ left the temple and saw a fig tree.

Matt 21:17 And he left them, and went out of the city into Bethany; and he lodged there.

18 Now in the morning as he returned into the city, he hungered.

19 And **when he saw a fig tree in the way**, he came to it, and found nothing thereon, but leaves only, and said unto it, Let no fruit grow on thee henceforward for ever. And **presently the fig tree withered away**.

Then the disciples marveled at the fig tree how it quickly withered.

Matt 21:20 And when the disciples saw it, they marvelled, saying, How soon is the fig tree withered away!

He then began to talk about this being done through great faith.

Matt 21:21

Jesus answered and said unto them, Verily I say unto you, **If ye have faith, and doubt not, ye shall not only do this which is done to the fig tree**, but also if ye shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; it shall be done.

Then I saw a man in great faith clothed in sackcloth standing in Jerusalem.

He cursed the bad figs of the Temple of God on earth and its bad figs just like the Day of Jeremiah.

Jer 24:24 The Lord shewed me, and, behold, two baskets of figs were set before the temple of the Lord, after that Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon had carried away captive Jeconiah the son of Jehoiakim king of Judah, and the princes of Judah, with the carpenters and smiths, from Jerusalem, and had brought them to Babylon.

2 One basket had very good figs, even like the figs that are first ripe: and the other basket had very naughty figs, which could not be eaten, they were so bad.

3 Then said the Lord unto me, What seest thou, Jeremiah? And I said, Figs; the good figs, very good; and the evil, very evil, that cannot be eaten, they are so evil.

4 Again the word of the Lord came unto me, saying,

5 Thus saith the Lord, the God of Israel; Like these good figs, so will I acknowledge them that are carried away captive of Judah, whom I have sent out of this place into the land of the Chaldeans for their good.

The good figs will depart out into an Exodus for thier good.

Jer 24:7 And I will give them an heart to know me, that I am the Lord: and they shall be my people, and I will be their God: for they shall return unto me with their whole heart.

These good figs will be called AMI or my people.

But the bad fig will be destroyed because they are cursed.

Jer 24:8 And as the evil figs, which cannot be eaten, they are so evil; surely thus saith the Lord, So will I give Zedekiah the king of Judah, and his princes, and the residue of Jerusalem, that remain in this land, and them that dwell in the land of Egypt:

9 **And I will deliver them to be removed into all the kingdoms of the earth for their hurt**, to be a reproach and a proverb, a taunt and **a curse**, in all places whither I shall drive them.

10 And I will send the sword, the famine, and the pestilence, among them, **till they be consumed from off the land** that I gave unto them and to their fathers.

The armies will be sent in to destroy these wicked figs again.

Then I saw again the man in great faith clothed in sackcloth standing in Jerusalem.

He cursed the bad figs in the fig tree in the Temple of God in heaven.

The I saw him turn and curse a third of the fig tree of heaven.

Then a third of the bad cursed figs fell to the earth but the good figs were saved for last.

Bad figs in the temple of God in heaven get thrown down to earth.

Rev 8:10 And **the third angel sounded**, and there fell a great star from heaven, burning as it were a lamp, and it fell upon the third part of the rivers, and upon the fountains of waters;

This bad fig falling is satan.

Rev 12:4 And **his tail drew the third part of the stars of heaven**, and did cast them to the earth: and the dragon stood before the woman which was ready to be delivered, for to devour her child as soon as it was born.

Rev 12:9 And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceiveth the whole world: **he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.**

These bad figs falling down to earth are a curse.

Good figs coming out of the Temple in the end are the angels on Christs descent to reap the wicked.

Rev 6:13 And the stars of heaven fell unto the earth, even as a **fig tree casteth her untimely figs, when she is shaken of a mighty wind.**

The mountain and fig tree of heaven.

This is as Christ had warned to learn.

Matt 24:32 Now **learn a parable of the fig tree**; When his branch is yet tender, and putteth forth leaves, ye know that summer is nigh:

33 So likewise ye, when ye shall see all these things, know that it is near, even at the doors. In heaven as on earth a sign and wonder.

The fig tree of third temple in earth will have bad figs that are cursed and destroyed and the good figs will be led out and saved for last on another Exodus.

So will heaven have cursed bad figs that will be destroyed and good figs saved for last for the harvest.

The temple of God on earth in Jerusalem is the fig tree and the temple of God in heaven in new Jerusalem is the fig tree in heaven.

These things will be done as the will of God on earth as it is in heaven.

Matt 6:10 Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.

These are the two witnesses of the fig trees on earth and in heaven for the end times that the law may be fulfilled as its written.

Deut 19:15 One witness shall not rise up against a man for any iniquity, or for any sin, in any sin that he sinneth: **at the mouth of two witnesses, or at the mouth of three witnesses, shall the matter be established.**

In heaven as on earth the fig tree of the end times.
