

The Lords bow.

Christ and His bow are what is seen in the prophesy of the end.

Christ is the one who rides the white horse.

Rev 19:11 And I saw heaven opened, and **behold a white horse**; and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war.

He wears many crowns.

Rev 19:12 His eyes were as a flame of fire, and **on his head were many crowns**; and he had a name written, that no man knew, but he himself.

The one leading the armies the Lord of Hosts is going forward first.

Revelation 6:2 (KJV) And I saw, and **behold a white horse**: and **he that sat on him had a bow**; and **a crown was given unto him**: and he went forth conquering, and to conquer.

Bow and a Crown given to him a crown to be King of kings.

Rev 19:16 And he hath on his vesture and on his thigh a name written, **King Of Kings**, And Lord Of Lords.

This bow is an instrument into the Kings hand. A weapon of His war.

It is the lion of Judah who opens the seals.

Revelation 5:5 (KJV) And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: behold, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, hath prevailed to open the book, and **to loose the seven seals thereof**.

The first seal is open by Christ and the rider on white horse going forward is Christ.

Rev 6:1 And I saw when **the Lamb opened one of the seals**, and I heard, as it were the noise of thunder, one of the four beasts saying, Come and see.

2 And I saw, and **behold a white horse**: and he that sat on him had a bow; and a crown was given unto him: and he went forth conquering, and to conquer.

This is Christ going forward with a BOW.

I am the BOW of the LORD that He has bent back. A BOW OF BRASS.

Job 20:24 (NASB) He may flee from the iron weapon,
But the bronze bow will pierce him.

Psalm 18:34 (NASB) He trains my hands for battle,
So that my arms can bend a bow of bronze.

The Lord is going to break the bows of the kings of the earth .

Hosea 1:5 (KJV) And it shall come to pass at that day, that **I will break the bow of Israel**, in the valley of Jezreel.

It is Christ alone who breaks the bows.

Psalm 46:9 (KJV) He maketh wars to cease unto the end of the earth; **he breaketh the bow**, and cutteth the spear in sunder; he burneth the chariot in the fire.

It is Him who breaks the bows.

Jeremiah 49:35 (KJV) Thus saith the Lord of hosts; Behold, **I will break the bow** of Elam, the chief of their might.

They will bring thier bows against Christ but they all their bows will be broken.

Rev 19:19 And I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against him that sat on the horse, and against his army.

ARROWS that fly out of my mouth will penetrate deep.

Psalm 64:7-10 (KJV)

7 But **God shall shoot at them with an arrow**; suddenly shall they be wounded.

8 So they shall make their own tongue to fall upon themselves: all that see them shall flee away.

9 And all men shall fear, and shall declare the work of God; for they shall wisely consider of his doing.

10 The righteous shall be glad in the Lord, and shall trust in him; and all the upright in heart shall glory.

The prophesies in the Quiver will shoot forth.

Psalm 7:13 He hath also prepared for him the instruments of death; he ordaineth **his arrows against the persecutors**.

He has sent forth arrows from his BOW.

2 Samuel 22:15 And **he sent out arrows, and scattered them**; lightning, and discomfited them.

Psalm 18:14 (KJV) Yea, **he sent out his arrows, and scattered them**; and he shot out lightnings, and discomfited them.

Thunder and lightening and arrows from the mouth of the BOW.

Psalm 21:12 (KJV) Therefore shalt thou make them turn their back, **when thou shalt make ready thine arrows upon thy strings** against the face of them.

The arrows that fly forth.

Psalm 45:5 (KJV) **Thine arrows are sharp in the heart of the king's enemies**; whereby the people fall under thee.

Psalm 77:17 (KJV) The clouds poured out water: the skies sent out a sound: **thine arrows also went abroad.**

Psalm 144:6 (KJV) Cast forth lightning, and scatter them: **shoot out thine arrows, and destroy them.**

Out of the mouth of the bow will come forth the Arrows of the Lord.

For I Am the Lords Brass BOW he has bent back and made ready.
