

The last call.

The story of ananias and saphira is a prophetic warning to the church for the end times.

There are two testifying that if you dont let go of your possessions for the end you will be handed over to death.

Act 5:5 But a certain man named **Ananias, with Sapphira** his wife, sold a possession,

2 And kept back part of the price, his wife also being privy to it, and brought a certain part, and laid it at the apostles' feet.

3 But Peter said, Ananias, why hath Satan filled thine heart to lie to the Holy Ghost, and to keep back part of the price of the land?

Acts 5:5 And Ananias hearing these words fell down, and gave up the ghost: and great fear came on all them that heard these things.

Ananias fell down and died. We then see Saphira came in after.

Acts 5: 6 And the young men arose, wound him up, and carried him out, and buried him.

7 And it was about the space of three hours after, when **his wife, not knowing what was done, came in.**

8 And Peter answered unto her, Tell me whether ye sold the land for so much? And she said, Yea, for so much.

9 Then Peter said unto her, How is it that ye have agreed together to tempt the Spirit of the Lord? behold, the feet of them which have buried thy husband are at the door, and shall carry thee out.

10 **Then fell she down straightway at his feet, and yielded up the ghost:** and the young men came in, and found her dead, and, carrying her forth, buried her by her husband.

We see they both were two witnesses of not letting go of thier possessions and being handed over to death.

Deut 19:15 One witness shall not rise up against a man for any iniquity, or for any sin, in any sin that he sinneth: **at the mouth of two witnesses, or at the mouth of three witnesses, shall the matter be established.**

The law states that a matter is estalished by two witnesses.

This matter is set to give ample explanation so that the Church when called is without excuse.

At the mouth of two witnesses the church is being warned.

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto my two witnesses, and they shall prophesy a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

The leaving possessions to come is found in the call for the gathering of the church.

When everyone is called to come...

Luke 14:16 Then said he unto him, A certain man made a great supper, and bade many:

17 And sent his servant at supper time to say to them that were bidden, **Come**; for all things are now ready.

18 And they all with one consent began to make excuse. The first said unto him, I have bought a piece of ground, and I must needs go and see it: I pray thee have me excused.

People begin to make excuses not willing to let go of thier possessions..

Luke 14:19 And another said, I have bought five yoke of oxen, and I go to prove them: I pray thee have me excused.

These people will be cutt off and handed over to death during the 1260 days of wrath.

This will be the last call to leave behind all your possessions and come..
