Rev 11:3 And **I will give power unto my two witnesses**, and they shall prophesy a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

The waters are dried up on the earth as the rain is stopped.

Rev 11:6 These have power to shut heaven, **that it rain not in the days of their prophecy**: and have power over waters to turn them to blood, and to smite the earth with all plagues, as often as they will.

Black sackclothe.

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto my two witnesses, and they shall prophesy a thousand two hundred and threescore days, **clothed in sackcloth.**

Rev 6:12 And I beheld when he had opened the sixth seal, and, lo, there was a great earthquake; and the sun became **black as sackcloth of hair**, and the moon became as blood;

The prophesy of the end times is found in the story of noah and the releasing of the Raven.

The Raven will be released just as the days of Noah.
