This is why Christ came first poor and without a home hungering in wilderness.

This is all prophetic foreshadow.

Christ ministry was 3 and half years. We see accounts of 3 passovers counted.

John 2:13 And the Jews' Passover was at hand, and Jesus went up to Jerusalem.

John 6:4 And the Passover, a feast of the Jews, was nigh.

John 11:55 And the Jews' Passover was nigh at hand: and many went out of the country up to Jerusalem before the Passover, to purify themselves.

We know that during His ministry Christ was made poor with no home and was hungered.

Christ went into the wilderness and hungered for bread.

Matt 4:4 Then was Jesus led up of the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted of the devil.

2 And when he had fasted forty days and forty nights, he was afterward an hungred.

3 And when the tempter came to him, he said, If thou be the Son of God, command that these stones be made bread.

We see that Christ explains a major revelation.

Matthew 8:20 And Jesus saith unto him, **The foxes have holes, and the birds of the air have nests; but the Son of man hath not where to lay his head.**

Foxes have holes in mountains which are caves. Birds have nests in the mountains.

Christ had no home or place of his own. He left it all behind.

Christ suffered all things including what the Bride will be going through in the end times.

Everyone is called to leave all things behind and come.

Mark 13:14 But when ye shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing where it ought not, (let him that readeth understand,) then let them that be in Judaea flee to the mountains:

15 And let him that is on the housetop not go down into the house, neither enter therein, **to take any thing out of his house:**

16 And let him that is in the field not turn back again for to take up his garment.

You leave everything behind and come.

Christ warned the temptation to stay behind because of your possessions would prevent you from coming.

Matt 19:21 Jesus said unto him, **If thou wilt be perfect, go and sell that thou hast, and give to the poor,** and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come and follow me.

22 But when the young man heard that saying, **he went away sorrowful: for he had great possessions.**

23 Then said Jesus unto his disciples, Verily I say unto you, That a rich man shall hardly enter into the kingdom of heaven.

Christ was showing the end times in his life and ministry. Being made poor is foreshadow.

James 2:5 Hearken, my beloved brethren, Hath not God chosen the poor of this world rich in faith, and heirs of the kingdom which he hath promised to them that love him?

The bride will be made poor before his coming... The Woman goes into the wilderness for 3 years and half.

Rev 12:6 And the woman fled into the wilderness, where she hath a place prepared of God, that they should feed her there a **thousand two hundred and threescore days.**

Where she has left all behind her houses, her garments, her things of possession that were sold and given to to the poor to help them come with her.

Rev 12:14 And to **the woman were given two wings of a great eagle**, that she might fly into the wilderness, into her place, where she is nourished for a time, and times, and half a time, from the face of the serpent.

The Woman as an eagle flying to her nest into the wilderness where she hungers for bread.

Foxes have holes in the mountains and birds have nests....

Matthew 8:20 And Jesus saith unto him, **The foxes have holes, and the birds of the air have nests;** but the Son of man hath not where to lay his head.

The Woman is given holes of foxes and nests of a birds in her poverty to rest her head. Where shes fed when hungering for bread in the wilderness.

Shes poor and left all behind.

The foreshadow of Christs ministry.
