


Gladio two edged

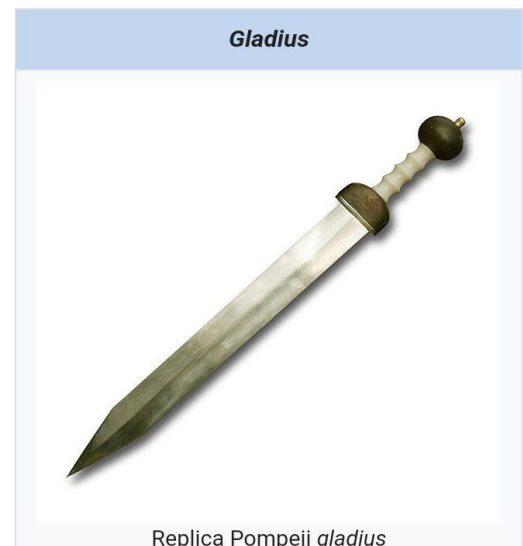

Gladius (Classical Latin: [ɡladius]) is a Latin word properly referring to the type of sword that was used by ancient Roman foot soldiers starting from the 3rd century BC and until the 3rd century AD. Linguistically, within Latin, the word also came to mean "sword", regardless of the type used.



This word DIS STOMA is meaning double mouthed.

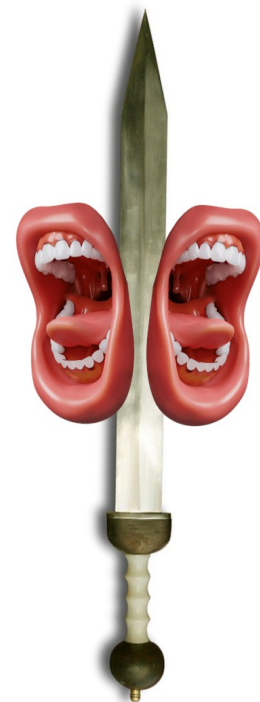
Revelation 2:16 Repent; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will fight against them **with the sword of my mouth.**

Rev 2:16 And he had in his right hand seven stars: and **out of his mouth went a sharp twoedged sword:** and his countenance was as the sun shineth in his strength.

Jeremiah 5:14 Wherefore thus saith the Lord God of hosts, **Because ye speak this word, behold, I will make my words in thy mouth fire**, and this people wood, and it shall devour them.

Out of the mouth... the word

Revelation 11:5 and if any man will hurt them, **fire proceedeth out of their mouth**, and devoureth their enemies: and if any man will hurt them, he must in this manner be killed.
