

## Mire and pit

The scriptures testify of two prophets forewarning of going to the pit with feet in the mire.

This is a foreshadow of the prophesy of the end times.

Jeremiah the prophet testified of prophesying in the darkness of the pit with his feet in the mire.

Jer 38:6 Then took they Jeremiah, and cast him into the dungeon of Malchiah the son of Hammelech, that was in the court of the prison: and they **let down Jeremiah with cords. And in the dungeon there was no water, but mire: so Jeremiah sunk in the mire.**

Jeremiah was down in the pit in the dark prophesying with his feet in the mire

David the prophet was prophesying of being in the pit and having the rock.

Psalm 40:2 He brought me up also **out of an horrible pit, out of the miry clay, and set my feet upon a rock**, and established my goings.

This is the foreshadow of the end times.

Here is the Rock that is foreshadowed by David having his feet on it to stand.

Rev 2:17 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the hidden manna, and **will give him a white stone**, and in the stone a new name written, which no man knoweth saving he that receiveth it.



We have two prophets testifying of a rock and going into the pit prophesying in the dark with thier feet in the miry clay.

This is the story in Daniel where the stone smites the image of the feet of iron and clay.

Dan 2:33 His legs of iron, his feet part of iron and **part of clay.**

34 Thou sawest till that a stone was cut out without hands, which smote the image upon his feet that were of iron and **clay**, and brake them to pieces.

35 Then was the iron, **the clay**, the brass, the silver, and the gold, broken to pieces together, and became like the chaff of the summer threshingfloors; and the wind carried them away, that no place was found for them: and **the stone that smote the image became a great mountain, and filled the whole earth.**



The two prophets prophesying against the feet of iron and clay having thier feet in the miry clay standing in the midst of the iron and clay.

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto **my two witnesses, and they shall prophesy** a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

Standing in the midst of the iron and clay at Jerusalem..

Rev 11:8 And **their dead bodies shall lie in the street of the great city**, which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt, where also our Lord was crucified.

Going down into the darkness of the pit for 3 days prophesying in the dark pit.

Rev 11:9 And they of the people and kindreds and tongues and nations shall **see their dead bodies three days and an half**, and shall not suffer their dead bodies to be put in graves.

Going into the pit of darkness prophesying for 3 days.

Rev 11:11 And **after three days and an half** the spirit of life from God entered into them, and **they stood upon their feet**; and great fear fell upon them which saw them.

Then being brought back up out of the pit standing on feet with the rock banner.

This is the prophesy foreshadowed 3 prophets, David , Jeremiah and Daniel that the law may be fulfilled.

Deut 19:15 One witness shall not rise up against a man for any iniquity, or for any sin, in any sin that he sinneth: **at the mouth of two witnesses, or at the mouth of three witnesses, shall the matter be established.**

The prophecy of two prophets with thier feet in the mire clay going into the pit and prophesying in darkness, being brought up out of the pit, while having thier feet firm on a rock.
