

Baker and Butler

The story of Joseph in Egypt and the Baker and Butler foreshadow the end times.

The story has two testifying of the events of the end times just as the prophecy.

Two are in Egypt the baker and butler.

Genesis 40:40 And it came to pass after these things, that the butler of the king of Egypt and his baker had offended their lord the king of Egypt.

2 And Pharaoh was wroth against **two of his officers**, against the **chief of the butlers**, and against the **chief of the bakers**.

This is foreshadow of two prophets in Spiritual Egypt.

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto **my two witnesses**, and **they shall prophesy** a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

Rev 11:8 And their dead bodies shall lie in the street of the great city, **which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt**, where also our Lord was crucified.

The dreams the butler and baker had are foreshadowing events of the end times.

They both had dreams of the future prophesy.

Gen 40:5 And **they dreamed a dream both of them**, each man his dream in one night, each man according to the interpretation of his dream, **the butler and the baker** of the king of Egypt, which were bound in the prison.

These dreams are prophetic telling of what will come.

Just as two prophesying what is to come.

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto **my two witnesses**, and **they shall prophesy** a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

The Butler had a dream testifying...

Gen 40:9 And the chief butler told his dream to Joseph, and said to him, In my dream, **behold, a vine was before me;**

10 And in the vine were three branches: and it was as though it budded, and her blossoms shot forth; and the clusters thereof **brought forth ripe grapes:**

11 And **Pharaoh's cup was in my hand:** and I took the grapes, and pressed them into Pharaoh's cup, and I gave the cup into Pharaoh's hand.

12 And Joseph said unto him, This is the interpretation of it: **The three branches are three days:**

13 Yet within **three days shall Pharaoh lift up thine head**, and **restore thee unto thy place:** and thou shalt deliver Pharaoh's cup into his hand, after the former manner when thou wast his butler.

This is prophetic imagery of what occurs after the three days of the two prophets.

After three days the two prophets will come alive and squeeze the grapes into the cup of the LORD.

Rev 11:11 And **after three days** and an half the spirit of life from God entered into them, **and they stood upon their feet**; and great fear fell upon them which saw them.

The squeezing the grapes into the winepress that are ripe.

The winepress of the Lord is the cup in thier hand and grapes are ripe.

Rev 14:18 And another angel came out from the altar, which had power over fire; and cried with a loud cry to him that had the sharp sickle, saying, Thrust in thy sharp sickle, and gather the clusters of the vine of the earth; **for her grapes are fully ripe.**

19 And the angel thrust in his sickle into the earth, and gathered the vine of the earth, and cast it into **the great winepress of the wrath of God.**

20 And the winepress was trodden without the city, and blood came out of the winepress, even unto the horse bridles, by the space of a thousand and six hundred furlongs.

The Bakers prophetic dream was also testifying...

Gen 40:16 When the **chief baker** saw that the interpretation was good, he said unto Joseph, **I also was in my dream**, and, behold, I had three white baskets on my head:

17 And in the uppermost basket there was of all manner of bakemeats for Pharaoh; and **the birds did eat them out of the basket upon my head.**

18 And Joseph answered and said, This is the interpretation thereof: **The three baskets are three days:**

19 Yet **within three days shall Pharaoh lift up thy head from off thee**, and shall hang thee on a tree; and **the birds shall eat thy flesh from off thee.**

This is the second prophetic foretelling of what happens after 3 days...

after these three days..

Rev 11:11 And **after three days** and an half the spirit of life from God entered into them, **and they stood upon their feet**; and great fear fell upon them which saw them.

The two will be lifted up back and restored to thier feet and begin to squeeze the grapes for the cup of the Lord.

Those executed in the winepress after those 3 days will be fed to the birds.

Rev 19:17 And I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the fowls that fly in the midst of heaven, Come and gather yourselves together unto the supper of the great God;

18 **That ye may eat the flesh of kings, and the flesh of captains, and the flesh of mighty men,** and the flesh of horses, and of them that sit on them, and the flesh of all men, both free and bond, both small and great.

This is the birds eating the bodies of those grapes squeezed for the cup of the Lords wrath.

Rev 19:21 And the remnant were slain with the sword of him that sat upon the horse, which sword proceeded out of his mouth: and all the fowls were filled with their flesh.

This is the prophetic foreshadow of the baker and the chief butler that is found in the end times prophecy of the two prophets.

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto **my two witnesses**, and **they shall prophesy** a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

Two prophesying the end of what occurs after those 3 days.
