

Noah's vineyard.

The story of Noah in the days of Noah is a prophetic foreshadow of Christ's return.

Noah after the rains stopped after the wrath planted a vineyard.

Genesis 8:8 And God remembered Noah, and every living thing, and all the cattle that was with him in the ark: and God made a wind to pass over the earth, and the waters assuaged;

2 The fountains also of the deep and the windows of heaven were stopped, and the **rain from heaven was restrained**;

Then Noah planted a vineyard and became a husbandman.

Gen 9:20 And **Noah began to be an husbandman, and he planted a vineyard**:

Noah began to be drunk.

Gen 9:21 And **he drank of the wine**, and was drunken; and he was uncovered within his tent.

Just as the days of Noah will prophetically be at the end of the world.

Matt 24:37 But **as the days of Noah were**, so shall also **the coming of the Son of man be**.

In the end times the rain stopped and the wrath of God poured out...

Rev 11:6 These have power to shut heaven, that it **rain not in the days of their prophecy**: and have power over waters to turn them to blood, and to smite the earth with all plagues, as often as they will.

The rains stopped.

Christ returns to His vineyard which is His kingdom.

John 15:15 **I am the true vine**, and my **Father is the husbandman**.

2 Every branch in me that beareth not fruit he taketh away: and every branch that beareth fruit, he purgeth it, that it may bring forth more fruit.

Christ plants His vineyard at Jerusalem.

Mark 12:7 But those husbandmen said among themselves, This is the heir; come, let us kill him, and the inheritance shall be ours.'

8 And they took him, and killed him, and cast him out of the vineyard.

9 What shall therefore the lord of the vineyard do? he will come and destroy the husbandmen, and will give the vineyard unto others.

The Kingdom of God's return on the earth is established back at Jerusalem after everyone is slain.

This is the prophetic wine that Noah was drunk with.

Rev 14:18 And another angel came out from the altar, which had power over fire; and cried with a loud cry to him that had the sharp sickle, saying, Thrust in thy sharp sickle, and gather the clusters of the vine of the earth; for her grapes are fully ripe.

19 And the angel thrust in his sickle into the earth, and gathered the vine of the earth, and cast it into the great winepress of the wrath of God.

20 And the winepress was trodden without the city, and blood came out of the winepress, even unto the horse bridles, by the space of a thousand and six hundred furlongs.

They will drink of the cup of the wine of wrath.

Rev 14:10 **The same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God**, which is poured out without mixture into **the cup of his indignation**; and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb:

Those who refuse to submit to the Husbandman of the vineyard will be turned into wine and drink of the cup of the wine of wrath and be drunk with that wine.

And you will see that cup.

Jer 25:17 Then took I the cup at the Lord's hand, and made all the nations to drink, unto whom the Lord had sent me:

Noah was the foreshadow of the end times planting of the vineyard after the wrath and rain stopped.
