

Nazarite grapes

The Nazarites grapes are found foreshadowed in the end times.

The Nazarite prophet

Numbers 6:2 Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, When either man or woman shall separate themselves to vow a vow of a Nazarite, to separate themselves unto the Lord:

3 He shall separate himself from wine and strong drink, and shall drink no vinegar of wine, or vinegar of strong drink, neither shall he **drink any liquor of grapes, nor eat moist grapes, or dried.**

4 All the days of his separation shall he eat nothing that is made of the vine tree, from the kernels even to the husk.

5 All the days of the vow of his separation there shall no razor come upon his head: until the days be fulfilled, in the which he separateth himself unto the Lord, he shall be holy, and shall let the locks of the hair of his head grow.

The prophetic signs of the Nazarite and the vine in the vineyard is the Kingdom of God.

The Nazarite is set apart in the Kingdom of God and is not to be touching any dead body which is figurative grapes, either freshly died or corpse in a tomb which is dried grapes.

This is to be done until all the days are fulfilled.

John the baptist was a foreshadow of my coming a prophet in sackclothe who was a nazarite.

Luke 1:15 For he shall be great in the sight of the Lord, and **shall drink neither wine nor strong drink;** and he shall be filled with the Holy Ghost, even from his mother's womb.

Sackclothe camel hair.

Matt 3:4 And the same John had **his raiment of camel's hair,** and a leathern girdle about his loins; and his meat was locusts and wild honey.

This foreshadow for 3 years and half of Johns ministry.

I am that Nazarite clothed in sackclothe for 3 years and half.

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto my two witnesses, and they shall **prophesy a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.**

After these days are fulfilled of the vow of 1260 days...

I will be brought to the door of the tabernacle by the High Priest Christ.

Numbers 6:10 And on the eighth day he shall bring two turtles, or two young pigeons, **to the priest, to the door of the tabernacle of the congregation:**

11 And the priest shall offer the one for a sin offering, and the other for a burnt offering, **and make an atonement for him**, for that he sinned by the dead, and shall hallow his head that same day.

The High priest Christ is the dove that descends and is offered for atonement.

Numbers 6:13 And this is **the law of the Nazarite**, when the days of his separation are fulfilled: he shall be brought unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation:

Then a sacrifice will occur according to the law of the Nazarite.

We will offer lambs rams and bulls and bread.

Numbers 6:14 And he shall offer his offering unto the Lord, **one he lamb** of the first year without blemish for a burnt offering, and one ewe lamb of the first year without blemish for a sin offering, and **one ram** without blemish for peace offerings,

15 And **a basket of unleavened bread**, cakes of fine flour mingled with oil, and wafers of unleavened bread anointed with oil, and their meat offering, and their **drink offerings**.

The bread is placed into the hands of the nazarite

Numbers 6:19 And the priest shall take the sodden shoulder of the ram, and **one unleavened cake out of the basket, and one unleavened wafer, and shall put them upon the hands of the Nazarite**, after the hair of his separation is shaven:

High Priest Christ has placed the hidden manna into my hands.

Rev 2:17 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh **will I give to eat of the hidden manna**, and will give him a white stone, and in the stone a new name written, which no man knoweth saving he that receiveth it.

Then the blood of lambs and rams and bullocks sacrifice and blood and wine and dead bodies are

Isaiah 34:5 For my sword shall be bathed in heaven: behold, it shall come down upon Idumea, and upon the people of my curse, to judgment.

6 The sword of the Lord is filled with blood, it is made fat with fatness, and with the **blood of lambs and goats, with the fat of the kidneys of rams**: for the Lord hath a sacrifice in Bozrah, and a great slaughter in the land of Idumea.

The wine and bodies.

Ezekiel 39:17 And, thou son of man, thus saith the Lord God; Speak unto every feathered fowl, and to every beast of the field, Assemble yourselves, and come; gather yourselves on every side to my sacrifice that I do sacrifice for you, even a great sacrifice upon the mountains of Israel, that **ye may eat flesh, and drink blood.**

18 Ye shall eat the flesh of the mighty, and drink the blood of the princes of the earth, **of rams, of lambs,** and of goats, of bullocks, all of them fatlings of Bashan.

19 And **ye shall eat fat** till ye be full, and **drink blood** till ye be drunken, of my sacrifice which I have sacrificed for you.

The Law of Nazarite meat and drink offering.

Numbers 6:15 And a basket of unleavened bread, cakes of fine flour mingled with oil, and wafers of unleavened bread anointed with oil, and their **meat offering,** and their **drink offerings.**

The bodies surrounding of dead grapes and wine.

Rev 19:17 And I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the fowls that fly in the midst of heaven, Come and gather yourselves together unto the supper of the great God;

18 That ye may eat the flesh of kings, and the flesh of captains, and the flesh of mighty men, and the flesh of horses, and of them that sit on them, and the flesh of all men, both free and bond, both small and great.

19 And I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against him that sat on the horse, and against his army.

The wine.

Rev 14:18 And another angel came out from the altar, which had power over fire; and cried with a loud cry to him that had the sharp sickle, saying, Thrust in thy sharp sickle, and gather the clusters of the vine of the earth; for her grapes are fully ripe.

19 And the angel thrust in his sickle into the earth, and gathered the vine of the earth, and cast it into the great winepress of the wrath of God.

After the days of the fulfillment of the vow we will fulfill the law of the Nazarite and partake of the wine.

The Nazarite has arrived.
