

Belly of the beast

The story of Jonah is a prophetic foreshadow of the 3 prophetic days of the 1260 days of the tribulation.

The prophet was swallowed in the beast of the seas belly.

Jonah 1:12 And he said unto them, **Take me up, and cast me forth into the sea**; so shall the sea be calm unto you: for I know that for my sake this great tempest is upon you.

Jonah 1:17 Now the LORD had prepared a great fish to swallow up Jonah. And Jonah was in the **belly of the fish three days and three nights**.

The prophet was then put onto dry ground.

Jonah 2:10 And the Lord spake unto the fish, and it **vomited out Jonah upon the dry land**.

The beast of the sea is in Jerusalem.

Rev 13:1 And **I stood upon the sand of the sea, and saw a beast rise up out of the sea**, having seven heads and ten horns, and upon his horns ten crowns, and upon his heads the name of blasphemy.

This beast is given power for 3.5 years which is prophetic 3.5 days or 42 months.

Rev 13:5 And there was given unto him a mouth speaking great things and blasphemies; and **power was given unto him to continue forty and two months**.

I will be swallowed into the belly of this beast prophesying for 3.5 days in the belly of the beast of the sea.

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto my two witnesses, and they **shall prophesy a thousand two hundred and threescore days**, clothed in sackcloth.

This beast shall kill me but I will be risen 3.5 days after.

Rev 11:11 And **after three days and an half the spirit of life from God entered into them**, and they stood upon their feet; and great fear fell upon them which saw them.

I have the rains withheld for those 3 years and half in the belly of the beast.

Rev 11:6 These have power to shut heaven, that **it rain not in the days of their prophecy**: and have power over waters to turn them to blood, and to smite the earth with all plagues, as often as they will.

When I stand I will stand on dry ground coming out of the belly of the beast.

Jonah 2:10 And the Lord spake unto the fish, and it **vomited out Jonah upon the dry land**.
