

Colt and grapes.

The prophesy in the book of Genesis of the coming messiah is revealed in the end times.

The prophesy in Genesis about the grapes and the donkey and colt is the first coming and second coming of Christ.

Genesis 49:10 The sceptre shall not depart from Judah, nor a lawgiver from between his feet, until Shiloh come; and unto him shall the gathering of the people be.

This coming of the messiah with his sceptre is referenced first and then we see the grapes and colt.

Genesis 49:11 **Binding his foal unto the vine, and his ass's colt unto the choice vine; he washed his garments in wine, and his clothes in the blood of grapes:**

The first point we look to is binding the foal to the vine.

The Kingdom of God is the vineyard as described in the parable.

Mark 12:7 But those husbandmen said among themselves, This is the heir; come, let us kill him, and the inheritance shall be ours.'

8 And they took him, and killed him, and **cast him out of the vineyard.**

9 What shall therefore the **lord of the vineyard do?** he will come and destroy the husbandmen, and will give **the vineyard unto others.**

So we see that the Vine is the vineyard and now we look to the foal which is a donkey.

This is the donkey which the kingdom of God followed at Christs first coming.

Genesis 49:11 **Binding his foal unto the vine, and his ass's colt unto the choice vine; he washed his garments in wine, and his clothes in the blood of grapes:**

we see that the donkey is ridden by Christ and people followed him. If a donkey is tied to a grape vine he will pull the grapevine out and the grapevine would follow the donkey...

Matt 21:5 Tell ye the daughter of Sion, Behold, thy King cometh unto thee, meek, and sitting upon an ass, and a colt the foal of an ass.

6 And the disciples went, and did as Jesus commanded them,

7 And brought the ass, and the colt, and put on them their clothes, and they set him thereon.

8 And a very great multitude spread their garments in the way; others cut down branches from the trees, and strawed them in the way.

9 And the multitudes that went before, and **that followed**, cried, saying, Hosanna to the son of David: Blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord; Hosanna in the highest.

We see the vineyard followed the vine followed the foal.

Now looking to the colt.

Genesis 49:11 Binding his foal unto the vine, and **his ass's colt unto the choice vine**; he washed his garments in wine, and his clothes in the blood of grapes:

We see that the colt which is the white horse is tied to the choice vine which is the finest of the kingdom of God at the Resurrection.

Here is Christ returning.

Rev 19:11 And **I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse**; and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war.

We see the choice vine, the finest of the kingdom following Him on the colt.

Rev 19:14 And **the armies which were in heaven followed him** upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean.

So we see that the colt is tied to the choice vine which causes them to follow his horse.

Further confirming this is the same time.

Genesis 49:11 Binding his foal unto the vine, and his ass's colt unto the choice vine; **he washed his garments in wine, and his clothes in the blood of grapes**:

His robes are washed in the wine of the wild grapes of the earth and the blood of them are on his garments as he treads the winepress.

Rev 19:13 And **he was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood**: and his name is called The Word of God.

Rev 19:15 And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and **he treadeth the winepress** of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

From treading the grapes of the earth.

Rev 14:18 And another angel came out from the altar, which had power over fire; and cried with a loud cry to him that had the sharp sickle, saying, Thrust in thy sharp sickle, and **gather the clusters of the vine of the earth; for her grapes are fully ripe**.

19 And the angel thrust in his sickle into the earth, and gathered the **vine of the earth**, and cast it into the **great winepress** of the wrath of God.

20 And **the winepress** was trodden without the city, and **blood came out of the winepress**, even unto the horse bridles, by the space of a thousand and six hundred furlongs.

So on the return to tread the wild grapes of the earth. The Colt will be bound to the choice vine.

We are that choice vine of the Kingdom of God who will follow His cold on His return to war.
