

Three and prophet

The foreshadowing of the book of Daniel is seen in the end times.

The prophet Daniel was exalted and he appointed 3 over dominion of provinces in babylon.

Daniel 1:3 And the king spake unto Ashpenaz the master of his eunuchs, that **he should bring certain of the children of Israel**, and of the king's seed, and of the princes;

4 Children in whom was no blemish, but well favoured, and skilful in all wisdom, and cunning in knowledge, and understanding science, and **such as had ability in them to stand in the king's palace**, and whom they might teach the learning and the tongue of the Chaldeans.

7 Unto whom the prince of the eunuchs gave names: for he gave unto Daniel the name of Belteshazzar; and to Hananiah, of Shadrach; and to Mishael, of Meshach; and to Azariah, of Abednego.

We see that King of Babylon brought in Daniel and with him 3.

When the prophet was exalted he appointed his friends over.

Dan 2:47 The king answered unto Daniel, and said, Of a truth it is, that your God is a God of gods, and a Lord of kings, and a revealer of secrets, seeing thou couldest reveal this secret.

48 Then **the king made Daniel a great man, and gave him many great gifts, and made him ruler over the whole province of Babylon**, and chief of the governors over all the wise men of Babylon.

49 Then **Daniel requested of the king, and he set Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, over the affairs of the province of Babylon**: but Daniel sat in the gate of the king.

So we see that Daniel set 3 over regions in babylon as satraps.

These 3 stood with Daniel in not worshiping the image of the king of babylon.

Dan 3:14 Nebuchadnezzar spake and said unto them, **Is it true, O Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego**, do not ye serve my gods, **nor worship the golden image** which I have set up?

They were put into the furnace of great tribulation.

Dan 3:24 Then Nebuchadnezzar the king was astonished, and rose up in haste, and spake, and said unto his counsellors, Did not we cast three men bound into the midst of the fire? They answered and said unto the king, True, O king.

25 He answered and said, Lo, I see four men loose, walking in the midst of the fire, and they have no hurt; and **the form of the fourth is like the Son of God**.

The Son of God stood with them.

They were put into the fiery trial of the great tribulation but were not burned.

Dan 3:26 Then Nebuchadnezzar came near to the mouth of the burning fiery furnace, and spake, and said, **Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego**, ye servants of the most high God, come forth, and come hither. Then Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, came forth of the midst of the fire.

This is all foreshadow of the end times.

The prophet will be exalted by the prophetic king of babylon.

He will appoint 3 over the king of babylons provinces of the 3 kings.

The prophet sets the kings for the Lord for the end times.

Dan 2:20 Daniel answered and said, Blessed be the name of God for ever and ever: for wisdom and might are his:

21 And he changeth the times and the seasons: **he removeth kings, and setteth up kings**: he giveth wisdom unto the wise, and knowledge to them that know understanding:

The ten kings in the end will have 3 kings appointed by the prophet decree..

Dan 7:20 And of the ten horns that were in his head, and of the other which came up, and **before whom three fell**; even of that horn that had eyes, and a mouth that spake very great things, whose look was more stout than his fellows.

These three are subdued by the king of babylon.

Dan 7:24 And the ten horns out of this kingdom are ten kings that shall arise: and another shall rise after them; and he shall be diverse from the first, and **he shall subdue three kings**.

The king of babylon will have three ribs in his mouth like the bear.

Dan 7:5 And behold another beast, a second, **like to a bear**, and it raised up itself on one side, and it had **three ribs in the mouth of it between the teeth of it**: and they said thus unto it, Arise, devour much flesh.

This is why the king of babylon has the feet of the bear.

Rev 13:2 And **the beast** which I saw was like unto a leopard, and **his feet were as the feet of a bear**, and his mouth as the mouth of a lion: and the dragon gave him his power, and his seat, and great authority.

King of babylon will burn third of the trees with fire which are regions of the 3 kings.

Rev 8:7 The first angel sounded, and there followed hail and fire mingled with blood, and they were cast upon the earth: and the **third part of trees was burnt up**, and all green grass was burnt up.

But the Son of God will stand with them in the fire like Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego.

These 3 kings will be called from the east by the prophet.

Rev 16:12 And **the sixth angel** poured out his vial upon the great river Euphrates; and the water thereof was dried up, that **the way of the kings of the east might be prepared.**

These 3 kings come across the euphrates which is in a province of babylon.

Rev 9:13 And the sixth angel sounded, and I heard a voice from the four horns of the golden altar which is before God,

14 Saying to the sixth angel which had the trumpet, Loose the four angels which are bound in the **great river Euphrates.**

15 And the four angels were loosed, which were prepared for an hour, and a day, and a month, and a year, for to slay the third part of men.

16 And the number of the army of the horsemen were two hundred thousand thousand: and I heard the number of them.

These armies come in to fight the king of babylon standing with Christ in the end.

The three provinces of the king of babylons kingdom and a prophet are all foretold.
