Daniel 1:3 And the king spake unto Ashpenaz the master of his eunuchs, that he should bring certain of the children of Israel, and of the king's seed, and of the princes;

Daniel 1:7 Unto whom the prince of the eunuchs gave names: for **he gave unto Daniel the name of Belteshazzar**; and to Hananiah, of Shadrach; and to Mishael, of Meshach; and to Azariah, of Abednego.

That a matter be established according to the law of two accounts.

Deut 19:15 One witness shall not rise up against a man for any iniquity, or for any sin, in any sin that he sinneth: at the mouth of two witnesses, or at the mouth of three witnesses, shall the matter be established.

The two prophets testifying...

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto my **two witnesses, and they shall prophesy** a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

The prophet in babylon that great city.

Rev 18:10 Standing afar off for the fear of her torment, saying, Alas, alas that **great city Babylon**, that mighty city! for in one hour is thy judgment come.

The prophet in Egypt that great city.

Rev 11:8 And their dead bodies shall lie in the street of **the great city**, which spiritually is called Sodom and **Egypt**, where also our Lord was crucified.

The stories of the old testament all foreshadow the end and testify.

The prophet of the end times will have a new name.
