

Grapes gathering

The law of gleaning grapes has always been a blessing for the gleaning grapes.

The prophesy and events of Christ first coming, end times and second coming are grapes gleaning.

First looking to the blessing of the law.

Leviticus 19:9 And when **ye reap the harvest of your land**, thou shalt not wholly reap the corners of thy field, **neither shalt thou gather the gleanings of thy harvest**.

Leviticus 19:10 And **thou shalt not glean thy vineyard**, neither shalt **thou gather every grape of thy vineyard**; thou **shalt leave them for the poor and stranger**: I am the Lord your God.

The grape gathering shall not completely remove all grapes and there should be leftover grapes for the poor and strangers.

The grapes are wild grapes and cultivated grapes.

The grapes that are cultivated are the vineyard of the kingdom.

Isa 5:1 Now will I sing to my wellbeloved a song of my beloved touching his vineyard. My wellbeloved hath a vineyard in a very fruitful hill:

Isa 2 And he fenced it, and gathered out the stones thereof, and **planted it with the choicest vine**, and built a tower in the midst of it, and also made a winepress therein: and he looked that it should bring forth grapes, and it brought **forth wild grapes**.

So when Christ came the first time to the vineyard to gather the grapes He made a new covenant.

We see that in the prophesy of the new covenant the grapes being mentioned.

Jer 31:29 In those days they shall say no more, **The fathers have eaten a sour grape**, and the children's teeth are set on edge.

Jer 31:30 But every one shall die for his own iniquity: **every man that eateth the sour grape**, his teeth shall be set on edge.

Jer 31:31 Behold, the days come, saith the Lord, that **I will make a new covenant** with the house of Israel, and with the house of Judah:

Christ took the cup of wine which is made from the blood of the grapes. The new covenant.

Luke 22:20 Likewise also the cup after supper, saying, **This cup is the new testament in my blood**, which is shed for you.

So with the blood of grapes the new covenant was made.

Mark 14:23 And **he took the cup**, and when he had given thanks, he gave it to them: and they all drank of it.

The other grapes were taken in the wine offering of this covenant.

Christ begins to talk about his vineyard...

Matthew 20:1 For the kingdom of heaven is like unto a man that is an householder, which went out early in the morning to hire labourers **into his vineyard.**

Then shortly after He begins to reference the cup of the wine from vineyard.

Matt 20:22 But Jesus answered and said, Ye know not what ye ask. **Are ye able to drink of the cup that I shall drink of,** and to be baptized with the baptism that I am baptized with? They say unto him, We are able.

23 And **he saith unto them, Ye shall drink indeed of my cup,** and be baptized with the baptism that I am baptized with: but to sit on my right hand, and on my left, is not mine to give, but it shall be given to them for whom it is prepared of my Father.

So establishing the new covenant is made with grapes and grapes are the kingdom.

The harvest of the grapevine came to make the new covenant with Christ being harvested first.

Those who rejected Christ out of the kingdom were cut off.

John 15:5 I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing.

6 If a man abide not in me, he is cast forth as a branch, and is withered; and men gather them, and cast them into the fire, and they are burned.

Christ didn't gather all of the grapes but left them behind in the field which was burned by Rome coming in and sacking. They were left behind for strangers..

Leviticus 19:10 And **thou shalt not glean thy vineyard,** neither shalt **thou gather every grape of thy vineyard;** thou **shalt leave them for the poor and stranger:** I am the Lord your God.

This is the first coming of Christ with the grape harvest.

The middle of the tribulation the gathering for the next exodus the vineyard will be bringing forth fruit at Jerusalem.

The next harvest is the gathering of the grapes which the 144,000 are sealed at Jerusalem Exodus,

Rev 7:3 Saying, Hurt not the earth, neither the sea, nor the trees, till we have sealed the servants of our God in their foreheads.

Rev 7:4 And I heard the number of them which were sealed: and there were sealed an **hundred and forty and four thousand of all the tribes of the children of Israel.**

The grapes will be gathered of the Remnant of the Church to Jerusalem and the grapes will exodus.

Those who dont come will stay behind at Jerusalem trying to fight.

Not all the grapes will be harvested but yet again will a remnant come out.

Leviticus 19:10 And **thou shalt not glean thy vineyard**, neither shalt **thou gather every grape of thy vineyard**; thou **shalt leave them for the poor and stranger**: I am the Lord your God.

The strangers coming in to Jerusalem to cutt down and burn the wild grapes is the beasts armies.

Rev 17:16 And the ten horns which thou sawest upon the beast, these shall hate the whore, and shall make her desolate and naked, and shall eat her flesh, and **burn her with fire**.

17 For God hath put in their hearts to fulfil his will, and to agree, and give their kingdom unto the beast, until the words of God shall be fulfilled.

These warnings are throughout scripture when the wicked come in to harvest they leave nothing.

Jeremiah 8:13 **I will surely consume them**, saith the Lord: **there shall be no grapes on the vine**, nor figs on the fig tree, and the leaf shall fade; and the things that I have given them shall pass away from them.

And on the coming of Christ the grapes of the earth will be harvested by the righteous.

Christ come in the darkness as a thief in the night for the grape harvest.

Jeremiah 49:9 **If grapegatherers come to thee, would they not leave some gleaning grapes? if thieves by night**, they will destroy till they have enough.

And again its said.

Obadiah 5 If **thieves came to thee, if robbers by night**, (how art thou cut off!) would they not have stolen till they had enough? **if the grapegatherers came to thee, would they not leave some grapes?**

These are warnings of the end times harvest of grapes. The gathering of the vine of the earth.

Revelation 14:18 And another angel came out from the altar, which had power over fire; and cried with a loud cry to him that had the sharp sickle, saying, Thrust in thy sharp sickle, and **gather the clusters of the vine of the earth; for her grapes are fully ripe**.

Revelation 14:19 And the angel thrust in his sickle into the earth, and **gathered the vine of the earth**, and cast it into the great winepress of the wrath of God.

This occurs on the first coming of Christ with the harvest of grapes.. This occurs on the harvest of the grapes for the 144,000 and the harvest of the grapes of the earth because there is a curse.

Deut 28:30 Thou shalt betroth a wife, and another man shall lie with her: thou shalt build an house, and thou shalt not dwell therein: **thou shalt plant a vineyard, and shalt not gather the grapes thereof**.

They were under the curse at each of the events and didnt gather the grapes.

The curse of the gathering of the grapes and their bodies being fed to worms is found in the law.

Deut 28:39 Thou shalt plant vineyards, and dress them, but shalt neither drink of the wine, nor gather the grapes; **for the worms shall eat them.**

The worms eat the bodies of the grapes killed in the harvest of the vine of the earth in end times.

Does not the hearing of the warning come with the blessing in the harvest of the earth?

Leviticus 19:10 And **thou shalt not glean thy vineyard**, neither shalt **thou gather every grape of thy vineyard**; thou **shalt leave them for the poor and stranger**: I am the Lord your God.

Is the law not honored for there to be some grapes spared leftover to rule over for the servants sake?

Isaiah 65:8 Thus saith the Lord, As the **new wine is found in the cluster**, and one saith, Destroy it not; **for a blessing is in it**: so will I do for my servants' sakes, that **I may not destroy them all.**

There will be a large portion of the grapes of the earth spared to rule over during the 1000 years.

There are grape gatherings coming.
