

Two blessings

The story of Isaac and Jacob and the blessing of the two is foreshadow of the end times prophesy.

Gen 48:48 And it came to pass after these things, that one told Joseph, Behold, thy father is sick: and he took with him his **two sons, Manasseh and Ephraim.**

2 And one told Jacob, and said, Behold, thy son Joseph cometh unto thee: and Israel strengthened himself, and sat upon the bed.

We see the Father (Jacob) and the Son(Joseph) having two heirs being blessed.

Gen 48:5 And now thy **two sons, Ephraim and Manasseh, which were born unto thee in the land of Egypt** before I came unto thee into Egypt, are mine; as Reuben and Simeon, they shall be mine.

We see two heirs in the land of Egypt.

This is a prophetic foreshadow of the end.

The Father and the Son is seen in the proverbs.

Prov 30:4 Who hath ascended up into heaven, or descended? who hath gathered the wind in his fists? who hath bound the waters in a garment? who hath established all the ends of the earth? **what is his name, and what is his son's name**, if thou canst tell?

The Father sent the Son in blessings.

Acts 3:26 Unto you first **God, having raised up his Son Jesus, sent him to bless you**, in turning away every one of you from his iniquities.

John 20:21 Then said Jesus to them again, Peace be unto you: as my Father hath sent me, even so send I you.

The end times we see the blessing of the Father on the Son's two heirs.

Rev 11:3 And **I will give power unto my two witnesses**, and they shall prophesy a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

These two heirs are in the land of Egypt.

Rev 11:8 And **their dead bodies** shall lie in the street of **the great city, which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt**, where also our Lord was crucified.

This is the prophetic foreshadow of the end times found in the blessing of Ephraim and Manasseh.
