Two blessings

The story of Isaac and Jacob and the blessing of the two is foreshadow of the end times prophesy.

Gen 48:48 And it came to pass after these things, that one told Joseph, Behold, thy father is sick: and he took with him his **two sons**, **Manasseh and Ephraim**.

2 And one told Jacob, and said, Behold, thy son Joseph cometh unto thee: and Israel strengthened himself, and sat upon the bed.

We see the Father (Jacob) and the Son(Joseph) having two heirs being blessed.

Gen 48:5 And now thy **two sons, Ephraim and Manasseh, which were born unto thee in the land of Egypt** before I came unto thee into Egypt, are mine; as Reuben and Simeon, they shall be mine.

We see two heirs in the land of Egypt.

This is a prophetic foreshadow of the end.

The Father and the Son is seen in the proverbs.

Prov 30:4 Who hath ascended up into heaven, or descended? who hath gathered the wind in his fists? who hath bound the waters in a garment? who hath established all the ends of the earth? what is his name, and what is his son's name, if thou canst tell?

The Father sent the Son in blessings.

Acts 3:26 Unto you first God, having raised up his Son Jesus, sent him to bless you, in turning away every one of you from his iniquities.

John 20:21Then said Jesus to them again, Peace be unto you: as my Father hath sent me, even so send I you.

The end times we see the blessing of the Father on the Son's two heirs.

Rev 11:3 And **I will give power unto my two witnesses**, and they shall prophesy a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

These two heirs are in the land of Egypt.

Rev 11:8 And their dead bodies shall lie in the street of the great city, which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt, where also our Lord was crucified.

This is the prophetic foreshadow of the end times found in the blessing of Ephraim and Manasseh.
