

## Prophets mantle

There are foreshadows of the mantle to come found in the stories of old.

The scriptures show two accounts of two prophets in the old testament who have mantles.

These are prophetic foreshadows of the end times.

First the account of Joseph and his mantle that made everyone jealous.

Gen 37:3 Now Israel loved **Joseph** more than all his children, because he was the son of his old age: and **he made him a coat of many colours.**

Gen 37:23 And it came to pass, when Joseph was come unto his brethren, that they stript Joseph out of his coat, **his coat of many colours that was on him;**

Josephs brothers envied his coat and cast him into a pit.

Gen 37:24 And they took him, and **cast him into a pit:** and the pit was empty, there was no water in it.

The coat was covered in blood.

Gen 37:31 And they took Joseph's coat, and killed a kid of the goats, and **dipped the coat in the blood;**

The prophet was stuck in Egypt.

Gen 37:28 Then there passed by Midianites merchantmen; and they drew and lifted up Joseph out of the pit, and sold Joseph to the Ishmeelites for twenty pieces of silver: and **they brought Joseph into Egypt.**

These are all forehadows of the end times prophesy.

Now looking to Elijahs mantle.

2 Kings 2:8 And **Elijah took his mantle**, and wrapped it together, and smote the waters, and they were divided hither and thither, so that they two went over on dry ground.

The mantle was desired.

2 Kings 2:13 He took up also **the mantle of Elijah** that fell from him, and went back, and stood by the bank of Jordan;

2 Kings 2:14 And **he took the mantle of Elijah that fell from him**, and smote the waters, and said, Where is the Lord God of Elijah? and when he also had smitten the waters, they parted hither and thither: and Elisha went over.

So we see two prophets, a mantle that others wanted and the mantle was covered in blood and the prophet put into a pit and bound to Egypt.

This is two accounts according to the law that establish a matter.

Deut 19:15 One witness shall not rise up against a man for any iniquity, or for any sin, in any sin that he sinneth: **at the mouth of two witnesses**, or at the mouth of three witnesses, shall the matter be established.

This is what is prophesied of the end times.

Two prophets

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto my **two witnesses**, and they shall prophesy a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

The two prophets mantles covered in blood.

Rev 11:7 And when they shall have finished their testimony, the beast that ascendeth out of the bottomless pit shall make war against them, and **shall overcome them, and kill them.**

Two prophets bound to Egypt.

Rev 11:8 And **their dead bodies** shall lie in the street of **the great city, which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt**, where also our Lord was crucified.

Two put into the pit.

Rev 11:11 And **after three days and an half** the spirit of life from God entered into them, and they stood upon their feet; and great fear fell upon them which saw them.

After three days and half coming to life raising out of the pit.

So we see the foreshadows of the old testament fulfilled in the end times.

Two prophets with mantle that have mantle covered in blood put into the pit being put in Egypt.

The prophet with the mantle is here.
