

Prophets portion

The bible foreshadows the prophesy of the end times prophets with two prophets accounts testifying of the foreshadow of the prophets of the end given authority to prophesy to the king.

The first account is with prophet Daniel.

Daniel was brought to the authority to prophesy to the king of Babylon.

Daniel 2:47 The **king answered unto Daniel**, and said, Of a truth it is, that your God is a God of gods, and a Lord of kings, and a revealer of secrets, seeing thou couldest reveal this secret.

Daniel 2:48 Then the **king made Daniel a great man**, and gave him many great gifts, and made him ruler over the whole province of Babylon, and chief of the governors over all the wise men of Babylon.

The second account is with prophet Joseph.

Joseph was brought to the authority to prophesy to the pharaoh of Egypt.

Genesis 41:41 And **Pharaoh said unto Joseph**, See, **I have set thee over all the land of Egypt**.

Genesis 41:42 And Pharaoh took off his ring from his hand, and put it upon Joseph's hand, and arrayed him in vestures of fine linen, and put a gold chain about his neck;

Genesis 41:43 And he made him to ride in the second chariot which he had; and they cried before him, Bow the knee: and he made him ruler over all the land of Egypt.

This is the accounts of two prophets being given dominion by the King of babylon and pharaoh of Egypt.

This is prophetic foreshadow of the end times for the 1260 days over Jerusalem.

Here is two prophets being given authority to prophesy from Jerusalem.

Rev 11:3 And **I will give power unto my two witnesses, and they shall prophesy** a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

Jerusalem is ruled by the Antichrist which is the prophetic king of Babylon and the False Prophet which is the prophetic pharaoh of Egypt.

Jerusalem is the prophetic babylon and Egypt.

Rev 18:10 Standing afar off for the fear of her torment, saying, Alas, alas **that great city Babylon**, that mighty city! for in one hour is thy judgment come.

That great city is Babylon and that great city is also called Egypt.

Rev 11:8 And **their dead bodies shall lie** in the street of **the great city**, which **spiritually is called** Sodom and **Egypt**, where also our Lord was crucified.

This is the fulfillment of the prophetic foreshadow of the two prophets given dominion over the kingdom of Babylon and Egypt.
